



Health Snippet - Temperance

Temperance: Total abstinence from substances that are harmful, moderate use of substances that are helpful.

- Moderation should be in diet, work, sleep, study, dress, etc...
- <u>Abstain from Alcohol, Tobacco products, Drugs of abuse, Caffeine containing drinks</u> Tea/Coffee/Cola's etc...
 <u>Adverse effects</u> The mind in discernment and judgement, Irritates stomach, Clogs the living machine, Poisons the body cells. <u>Buys</u> Wretchedness, Poverty, Disease, Degradation, Lust, Crime, Death, etc...
- <u>Alcohol</u>: can damage parts of the brain, affecting behaviour and the ability to learn and remember. Risk factor for cancers of the mouth and throat, cause high blood pressure, heart attack or stroke. Effects kidneys, lungs, liver, stomach, pancreas, intestine, bones, skin, etc.....
- <u>Smoking Effects</u>: Cancers. The nicotine and carbon monoxide in each cigarette temporarily increases the heart rate and blood pressure, straining your heart and blood vessels, causing fat deposits to narrow and block blood vessels which leads to heart attack. It slows your blood flow, cutting off oxygen to your feet and hands.

 <u>Passive smoking</u>: Immediate effects include eye irritation, headache, cough, sore throat, dizziness and nausea. Causes lower respiratory tract infections such as <u>bronchitis</u>, <u>pneumonia and bronchiolitis in children</u>.
- <u>Drugs Effects</u>: If addicted, usually loses interest in many areas of life, including school, sports, family, and friends. Use can lead to feelings of paranoia and anxiety, memory and judgment are affected, and have a distorted view of time and distance. Also cause difficulty in differentiating reality and fantasy & headaches.
- If you want to build a new house: You find a nice piece of property, but the land is over an old toxic waste dump. Some experts tell you that there is no proof of any risk from living above that dump. Others have grounds for concern that living there will increase your risk of cancers of the kidney, breast, pancreas, ovary, bladder, and colon. Do you roll the dice and move in, or do you say, "Why take the risk?"


INTRODUCTION TO JUDGEMENT

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:



All humanity will be Judged

As we study, we'll see that the judgment is good news, because our Lord God works for His people. He judges in their behalf before the onlooking universe and grants them entrance into Christ's eternal kingdom, the culmination of all their hopes as followers of the Lord.







The word JUDGEMENT fills the mind with questions:

- Who will be judged?
- How is evidence gathered?
- Must I defend myself with my stammering mouth or does Heaven provide legal help?



- Who decides Satan's sentence?
- Why does God need a judgement anyway?
- Doesn't He already know everything about everyone?
- Do I have even the slightest chance of being pronounced innocent in the judgement - in light of my conduct?



Who will face Heaven's Judgement?



For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things *done* in *his* body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

- 2 Corinthians 5:10


The theme of divine judgment runs through the entire Bible.

Both themes are woven together in Scripture from Genesis through Revelation.


And no wonder. Judgment and salvation reflect twin aspects of God's character: His justice and grace.



Need to Ponder

These are a sample of the texts that clearly teach judgment. Many of the most explicit judgment texts, texts that clearly reveal the reality of divine judgment, or judgments, appear in the New Testament. This fact works against the notion that judgment is contrary to the newcovenant concept of God's grace, which is also taught in the New Testament. What this should teach us is that, however we understand judgment, and however we understand grace, we must understand them as divine truths that work together. To pit one against the other is to misunderstand the fullness of the gospel, which we looked at last week.



When will the Judgement begin?

The vision in Daniel 7 shows the moment when the Investigative Judgment begins at Heaven.



- Daniel 7:1-7. Four beasts come up. They represent four world empires, from Babylon to Rome.
- Daniel 7:8, 21, 25. A little horn represents the continuation of the Roman Empire. It makes war against the saints for "a time and times and half a time".
- Daniel 7:9-10. The Investigative Judgment begins.
- 4. Daniel 7:11-12. Last events on Earth.
- Daniel 7:13-14. Jesus receives the Kingdom from the Father.
- Daniel 7:22, 26. The saints receive the Kingdom.

The Judgment begins before the Second Coming (3) when some events are still happening on Earth (4)
When the judgment ends, Jesus receives the Kingdom (5) and He comes to Earth to give that Kingdom to the saints (6; see Rev. 20:4)




Why is the Judgement necessary

If "the Lord knows those who are His" (1Ti. 2:19), then why is a judgment necessary to decide who is saved and who isn't?

When Satan rebelled, he questioned the character and law of God. He questioned Him and cast doubt among the angels and the non-fallen worlds.

Of course our omniscient God is fully aware of who His people are. He does not need a judgment in order to decide who is going to be saved. The pre-Advent judgment, rather, shows the Judge to be just in the saving of His people.

Heavenly beings need to be sure that the saints are safe to save. As we seek to understand the meaning of the judgment, we need to remember the reality of the great controversy scenario, which is hinted at in these texts, because we see the angelic host witnessing the judgment. Other beings have an interest in the final outcome of the plan of salvation.



Let's examine the fall of Adam and Eve

Read Genesis 3, the account of the Fall. In what ways are the themes of judgment and grace revealed?

Satan succeeded in bringing sin into the world, changing everything as a result. Immediately, though, the Lord entered, calling out to Adam and Eve, "Where are you?"

This question doesn't have to be seen as condem**natory;** it was more an invitation to come to Him, the One who created and loved them. It was a call to turn away from their deceiver and to return to their Maker.



Judgement after the fall in Genesis


Notice, too, what happens. The first few lines from the mouth of God in this fallen world are questions (see Gen. 3:9, 11, 13). Then the first thing God says after He's finished questioning is to declare His judgment against the serpent, But next, in verse 15, even amid His judgment against the serpent, what does God say?





Salvation – Judgement and Grace

Verse 15 is the first gospel promise. As soon as He declares His judgment against the serpent, He then immediately gives the first message of grace, of redemption, of salvation for humanity. And only then, only after that gospel promise, does He start declaring His judgments against the woman and the man. Although they fell, the first things God gives them are hope and grace—the grace that forms the background against which judgment is to unfold. Thus, even before judgment, the promise of grace is given for those who will accept it.











Need to Ponder

How often has God revealed His grace to you? More times than you can count, probably. How can you learn to better surrender to that grace and let it mold you into the image of Christ?






The World will be Judged



Grace and Judgement go hand in Glove

Two themes appear in these texts, grace and judgment, and they are radically intertwined.

Sin and darkness and evil have brought the need for a God of justice to judge and condemn these things.




At the same time, God's grace offers a way out to those who are guilty, and that comes by faith in Jesus Christ. He who believes in Jesus is not condemned. That's what the texts say. It's that simple. Christ's righteousness covers that person, and that person stands without condemnation, now and in the judgment.



Everyone is condemned: need Grace

Everyone stands condemned; everyone, though, who, through the grace of Christ, accepts the provision offered, stands pardened, justified, and redeemed through Jesus. The condemnation that is theirs is, through the merits of Jesus, canceled, and they stand in His perfect righteousness. In fact, what does grace mean apart from the prospect of condemnation? Just as the idea of condemnation implies judgment, so does the idea of grace. Were there no potential for judgment (and condemnation), there would be no need for grace. The notion of grace itself all but demands the notion of condemnation. Hence, more reason to see how grace and judgment are in keet

The Pen of Inspiration – Spirit of Prophecy







The Three Phases of God's Judgement

1. Phase # 1:

Pre-Second Advent Judgement.

- 1 Peter 4:17-18

2. Phase # 2:

Judgement During the 1,000

Years. – Revelation 20:4, 11-13

3. Phase # 3:

Judgement at the Close of the 1,000 Years. – Revelation 20:9-10, 14



1 - Investigative Judgement





How will the Judgement take place?

God followed the same steps in all His judgments. Those steps are investigating, deciding and executing. That's why the first phase of the Judgment is called INVESTIGATIVE JUDGMENT.



Adam and Eve: Genesis 3:9-24.

- Investigation: He interrogated Adam and Eve (v. 9-13)
- Decision: He issued a verdict (v. 14-19)
- Execution: They were expelled from Eden (v. 23-24)



Cain: Genesis 4:9-16.

- Investigation: He interrogated Cain (v. 9-10)
- Decision: He issued a verdict (v. 11-12)
- Execution: Cain was expelled from his land (v. 16)



Babel: Genesis 11:4-9.

- Investigation: He came down to see what they were doing (v. 5-6)
- Decision: He decided to punish them by confusing their language (v. 7)
- Execution: He scattered them over the face of all the earth (v. 8)



Sodom:


Gen. 18:16-19:28.

- Investigation: Two angels came to investigate (18:20-22)
- Decision: He issued the verdict (19:15)
- Execution: Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah and Zeboim were destroyed (19:24-25)

Investigation involves deliberation and fairness in the Judgment.

In Genesis 2-3 KJB we read ...

"... the voice (Jesus, the Son) of the LORD God (Father) ..." then investigates, inquiring and asking questions (Gen. 3:9-19 KJB; not that God does not know, but it is for the benefit of the angels (Gen. 3:24) KJB) and Adam/Eve and us), having already warned man of the sentence for sin (Gen. 2:17 KJB), gives judgment, yet also hope while time lasts (Gen. 3:15 KJB).






In Genesis 2-3 KJB we read ...




In Genesis 4 KJB we read ...

And afterward, when the heart of Cain was revealed (Gen. 4:9; Mat. 12:34; Luk. 6:45 KJB), Cain was marked & he fled from God's presence (Gen. 4:10-12 KJB).





In Genesis 6-9 KJB we read ...

"And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually."

- Genesis 6:5 KJB

"And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth."

In Genesis 10-11 KJB we read ...

... that the people again rebelled after the flood, attempting to make a way to God in a way differing than God specified.

God then personally came down to see, look and investigate, before the execution of Judgment in the separation of the languages and scattering of the people (to fulfill his word, Gen. 1:28 KJB).





In Genesis 17-19 KJB we read ...

"And the LORD said, Because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous;"

— Genesis 18:20 KJB

"I will go down now, and see whether they have done altogether according to the cry of it, which is come unto me; and if not, I will know." – Genesis 18:21 KJB





In Exodus 16 - Numbers 15:32-36 KJB we read ...

"And the LORD said unto Moses, <u>How long</u> refuse ye to keep my commandments and my laws?" – Exodus 16:28 KJB

The Investigation in Judgement





In Job KJB we read ...

In the Gospels KJB of Jesus we read ...

... Jesus himself came to see/investigate/judge Israel, before the execution of Judgment.

"Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, <u>Behold, these three years I</u> come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground?" – Luke 13:7 KJB

"And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season." Revelation 20:2, 3

Lets Examine Revelation 20

Chapter 20 shows us what is going to happen after Jesus comes and gathers His dear children from off this earth. It talks about Satan getting tied up with a great chain. Now remember these picture stories are full of symbols. You could not tie up a spirit being with a real chain. It says he is cast into a 'bottomless pit', which means a place that is empty and deserted.

What happens when Jesus comes? All the people who have chosen to belong to Him are taken up into the cloud to go to heaven with Jesus. All the people who chose to go their own way and fight against God and His law are killed. So who is left? Just Satan and his angels.





Satan making His Case in the Universe

When Satan was first cast out of heaven, he was allowed to come back and visit at times. But after he cruelly killed dear Jesus on the cross, the angels would not allow him to even visit anymore. He can still visit other planets though, and they are looking forward to the day when he can't come any more, because even though he cannot harm them, he likes to tell them all about the bad things God's children are doing. But when Jesus returns and takes His people to the heavenly city, God is going to stop Satan and his angels from being able to leave this planet.

For one thousand years these cruel and rebellious angels will have nothing to do except walk around and see the terrible mess they made of this once beautiful planet. Everywhere the cities are all smashed; the houses are all broken; nothing is left alive and there will be maybe dead bodies everywhere. And dark and dismal.





The Deception of Satan

The devil has only his evil angels to tempt and mislead, and they, after 6,000 years, are as bad as he is. This earth becomes his prison. He wanted to show how he would rule the world, so he took the dominion from Adam and Eve by deceit, and everyone throughout the years on planet earth! Satan has made claims and promises to many people who have worshipped him directly down through the ages. He has said that he will raise all his followers from the dead.

But Satan has no life in him and cannot raise even one of them.

Friends, that is the destiny of all who choose this world's so-called pleasures— to be one of the dead with the second coming of Jesus! Satan may give you the idea that the wrong things of this earth are 'fun' and that having your own way is what you need to try and do. But he doesn't have his own way, even now, and he sure won't in the future.





Phase # 2: Judgement During the 1000 Years

When will the wicked be judged?
Rev. 20:4

 "And judgement was given unto them ... and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years."





Judgement given to the Saints – 1 Corinthians 6:2-3

"And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection." Revelation 20:4, 5.



There is only one way to be truly happy and to 'have your own way' and that is to always choose God's ways. You see Jesus knows what is good, and He also knows what will only lead to pain and death. Everything the Bible tells us not to do, is because those things will hurt you sooner or later. Remember this when you feel angry that you can't have things the way you want.



The 1000 years of Judgement

What will the people, who go to heaven, do during the thousand years that Satan is stuck on this earth? They get to open the books and see why the ones who are lost are not in heaven. There may be someone who you thought would be in heaven and when you get there you look around and you don't find him or her. You will go and look in the books and there you will learn why they are not able to be there.





Saints Judge the Angels – 1 Corinthians 6:2-3

But more than this, we will judge the wicked people and the wicked angels. Each life will be looked at carefully, and the amount of time they must suffer in the final punishment, before they die forever, is written by each name. This is only fair of God, for some, like Satan's angels, have spent thousands of years doing cruel and horrible things while some people only lived a few years doing nasty things.



I have long looked forward to the time in heaven when we get to see history as it REALLY happened; when all the lies that have been told to us are exposed and the TRUTH is seen. Then we will see the stories of the poor martyrs who were killed hidden away where nobody knew about it. We will see how greedy and selfish men, under the control of devils, planned the terrible wars and cruel happenings in this world, behind the scenes.

The Truth and Lies will be Revealed

We will know the truth about many leaders in the churches who pretend to be holy and are greatly admired, but behind the scenes, when they think nobody sees, they are wicked and cruel. We will know about how the corrupt ceremonies of Rome came down through the ages from before the flood. All questions will be answered, never again will we have to say, "I don't know".



We will also see the true and brave deeds of the redeemed, even little children that nobody knew about, who bravely stood for their faith in Jesus even unto death. In that day all TRUTH will be known. Learn to love TRUTH now— and don't watch, read, or make up, or listen to things that are not true. Only TRUTH will set you free and keep you free; lies and fiction will only enslave you and end up destroying you. (John 8:32)



Phase # 3: Judgement at the Close of the 1000 Years

What happens to loose Satan out of his prison?

Well, at the end of the thousand years Jesus returns to earth. At this time His feet touch the mount of olives and it spits in half forming a great plain. Then the Holy City the New Jerusalem from heaven comes down to earth and settles on this plain.

It is at this time that the wicked dead are raised. For once everyone who ever lived on earth is alive at the same time. The wicked come forth from the grave in the same condition they went in. What a contrast is seen between the redeemed and the lost hosts of Satan's kingdom. They come up with the same marks of sin and disease, cruelty and hatred on them as they had when they died; while the righteous are bright and beautiful.



ZECHARIAH 1

Satan gathers a mighty army to take over

Satan goes forth among the vast multitude of resurrected wicked, and makes the feeble strong. He then points them to the countless millions who have been raised, and makes them believe that he, by his power, had brought them up from they graves. He points to the powerful race who lived before the flood, and to kings and warriors who were well skilled in battle, and flatters his subjects that their numbers are much greater than those in the city, that they can make war with them, and dethrone God and his Son Jesus Christ, and take the throne and occupy the city, and enjoy its richness and glory. As the wicked come forth from their graves, they resume the current of their thoughts where it ceased in death.



"And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them." Revelation 20:9



Satan, his angels and the wicked are destroyed

The antediluvian race perished blaspheming God. Many perished in battle; they fell while thirsting to conquer; they rise with the same spirit of war that they possessed when they fell. They accept Satan as their general, and his angels as their officers. Satan and his angels were once inhabitants of the city; and they profess to understand just how to attack the city and take possession of it. With Satan at their head, they go up on the breadth of the earth, and compass the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city; and fire comes down from God out of Heaven and devours them.



"And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever."

Revelation 20:10. (Remember that for ever and ever, means as long as their life lasts. it does not mean everlasting life in an eternal burning hell. The wages of sin are death, not living forever in Hell.)

The Conclusion of the Judgement

"And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." Revelation 20:11-15.



Satan and Wicked have final view Jesus the King



Far above the city, upon a foundation of burnished gold, is a throne, high and lifted up. Upon this throne sits the Son of God, and around Him are the subjects of His kingdom. The power and majesty of Christ no language can describe, no pen portray. The glory of the Eternal Father is enshrouding His Son. The brightness of His presence fills the City of God, and flows out beyond the gates, flooding the whole earth with its radiance.



The whole wicked world stand arraigned at the bar of God on the charge of high treason against the government of heaven. They have none to plead their cause; they are without excuse; and the sentence of eternal death is pronounced against them.

The Wicked are now in despair for their decisions

Jesus and his loyal subjects ascend to the top of the city. The wicked host behold the splendor of the city, and the happy redeemed company upon its walls, and are amazed at the scene. They behold Jesus in his kingly majesty, his countenance surpassing the brightness of the sun, surrounded by the angelic throng. As the wicked look upon the redeemed, and see their faces radiant with glory, and glittering crowns upon their heads, their courage fails, and they wail in anguish as they realize that they chose a life of rebellion against God, and Jesus Christ their Saviour, and for their disloyalty have lost eternal



life, and an imperishable treasure.

Then many who had professed to be Christ's followers, but who had not honored God in their lives, enumerate their good deeds performed when they lived upon the earth, and entreat to be admitted into the city. They plead that their names were upon the church books, and they had prophesied in the name of Christ, and in his name cast out devils, and done many wonderful works.

No more hope, No more opportunities!

Christ answers, Your cases have been decided. Your names are not found enrolled in the book of life. You professed to believe in my name, but you trampled upon the law of God. I know you not, depart from me ye workers of iniquity. Satan and his angels try to encourage the wicked multitude to action; but fire descends from Heaven, and unites with the fire in the earth, and aids in the general conflagration.



As powerful and important as the rebellious powers of earth may seem now—in that day things will be very different. Today is the time, when mercy still lingers; when Jesus still pleads in the Heavenly sanctuary and ALL POWER is available to overcome sin in the Name of Jesus; this is when we must hasten to make our future secure. Just claiming to believe at some point in your life, is not enough—remember Jesus said that some of the lost cry 'Lord, Lord' to Him. They had made a 'profession' of faith in Jesus but they had never surrendered their whole selves and overcame sin in the Power of the Blood of the Lamb and chose a life of obedience to the Law of God. (Matthew 7:21)








What is the distance around God's great city? Rev. 21: 16

 - <u>In Human estimate</u>: At least 39 billion people could live in the holy city, which is at least 5 times the current world population!




