



And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,


Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.





# The Pen of Inspiration by EG White

At the commencement of the holy Sabbath, January 5, 1849, we engaged in prayer with Brother Belden's family at Rocky Hill, Connecticut, and the Holy Ghost fell upon us. I was taken off in vision to the most holy place, where I saw Jesus still interceding for Israel. On the bottom of His garment was a bell and a pomegranate. Then I saw that Jesus would not leave the most holy place until every case was decided either for salvation or destruction, and that the wrath of God could not come until Jesus had finished His work in the most holy place, laid off His priestly attire, and clothed Himself with the garments of vengeance. Then Jesus will step out from between the Father and man, and God will keep silence no longer, but pour out His wrath on those who have rejected His truth. I saw that the anger of the nations, the wrath of God, and the time to judge the dead were separate and distinct, one following the other, also that Michael had not stood up, and that the time of trouble, such as never was, had not yet commenced. The nations are now getting angry, but when our High Priest has finished His work in the sanctuary, He will stand up, put on the garments of vengeance, and then the seven last plagues will be poured out. {EW 36.1}





# The Pen of Inspiration by EG White

I saw that the four angels would hold the four winds until Jesus' work was done in the sanctuary, and then will come the seven last plagues. These plagues enraged the wicked against the righteous; they thought that we had brought the judgments of God upon them, and that if they could rid the earth of us, the plagues would then be stayed. A decree went forth to slay the saints, which caused them to cry day and night for deliverance. This was the time of Jacob's trouble. Then all the saints cried out with anguish of spirit, and were delivered by the voice of God. The 144,000 triumphed. Their faces were lighted up with the glory of God. Then I was shown a company who were howling in agony. On their garments was written in large characters, "Thou art weighed in the balance, and found wanting." I asked who this company were. The angel said, "These are they who have once kept the Sabbath and have given it up." I heard them cry with a loud voice, "We have believed in Thy coming, and taught it with energy." And while they were speaking, their eyes would fall upon their garments and see the writing, and then they would wail aloud. I saw that they had drunk of the deep waters, and fouled the residue with their feet-trodden the Sabbath underfoot- and that was why they were weighed in the balance and found wanting. {EW 36.2}






#### The Close of Probation - Eden

What is the Close of Probation? When is the Close of Probation?

And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die. – Genesis 2:15-17

They were put on probation. When Adam and Eve had shown their loyalty to God by avoiding the tree and not touching or eating from it, He would have removed it. In Genesis 3, we find the story of the fall of Adam and Eve after they had touched and eaten of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. They did finally die. Thank God for the story of the serpent and Jesus in Genesis 3:15. Adam and Eve did not die without any hope. On the contrary, they were faithful once more to Jesus and will be raised in the resurrection at the end of time. So can everyone else who loves his appearing.



#### Wrath of God - Garden of Eden


To man the first intimation of redemption was communicated in the sentence pronounced upon Satan in the garden. The Lord declared, "I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel." Genesis 3:15. Adam and Eve stood as criminals before the righteous Judge, awaiting the sentence which transgression had incurred; but before they heard of the life of toil and sorrow which must be their portion, or of the decree that they must return to dust, they listened to words that could not fail to give them hope.

# Wrath of God - Flood

Beasts of every description, the fiercest as well as the most gentle, were seen coming from mountain and forest and quietly making their way toward the ark. A noise as of a rushing wind was heard, and lo, birds were flocking from all directions, their numbers darkening the heavens, and in perfect order they passed to the ark. Animals obeyed the command of God, while men were disobedient. Guided by holy angels, they "went in two and two unto Noah into the ark," and the clean beasts by sevens. The world looked on in wonder, some in fear. Philosophers were called upon to account for the singular occurrence, but in vain. It was a mystery which they could not fathom. As the doomed race beheld the sun shining in its glory, and the earth clad in almost Eden beauty, they banished their rising fears by boisterous merriment, and by their deeds of violence they seemed to invite upon themselves the visitation of the already awakened wrath of God. – Patriarchs and Prophets 97.3



# The Close of Probation - Flood

Here is another biblical example of the Close of Probation. At the time of the flood, Noah made one last appeal for everyone who would, to come into the ark. Noah went into the ark with his family, and one week later, the Deluge came on the world.

The Three Angels (Rev 14:6-12), that would be every one of you, are sounding the last message of mercy to the people who live on the earth. When everyone has received the Seal of God or the Mark of the Beast, Jesus will declare, "it is done." (Rev 21:6). It is then that the seven angels come out of the temple and begin pouring out their vials upon the earth.



# Wrath of God - Tower of Babel

The men of Babel had determined to establish a government that should be independent of God. There were some among them, however, who feared the Lord, but who had been deceived by the pretensions of the ungodly and drawn into their schemes. For the sake of these faithful ones the Lord delayed His judgments and gave the people time to reveal their true character. As this was developed, the sons of God laboured to turn them from their purpose; but the people were fully united in their Heaven-daring undertaking. Had they gone on unchecked, they would have demoralized the world in its infancy. Their confederacy was founded in rebellion; a kingdom established for self-exaltation, but in which God was to have no rule or honour. Had this confederacy been permitted, a mighty power would have borne sway to banish righteousness—and with it peace, happiness, and security—from the earth. —Patriarchs and Prophets, 123.1

# Wrath of God - Sodom & Gomorrah

Though Lot had become a dweller in Sodom, he did not partake in the iniquity of its inhabitants. Abraham thought that in that populous city there must be other worshipers of the true God. And in view of this he pleaded, "That be far from thee, to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked; ... that be far from thee. Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?" Abraham asked not once merely, but many times. Waxing bolder as his requests were granted, he continued until he gained the assurance that if even ten righteous persons could be found in it, the city would be spared.— Patriarchs and Prophets, 139, 140.



# Wrath of God - Pharaoh

Suddenly a darkness settled upon the land, so thick and black that it seemed a "darkness which may be felt." Not only were the people deprived of light, but the atmosphere was very oppressive, so that breathing was difficult. "They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings." The sun and moon were objects of worship to the Egyptians; in this mysterious darkness the people and their gods alike were smitten by the power that had undertaken the cause of the bondmen. Yet fearful as it was, this judgment is an evidence of God's compassion and His unwillingness to destroy. He would give the people time for reflection and repentance before bringing upon them the last and most terrible of the plagues.

The Father's glory and sustaining presence had left Him, and despair pressed its crushing weight of darkness upon Him and forced from His pale and quivering lips the anguished cry: "My God, My God, why hast Thou forsaken Me?" (Testimonies for the Church, vol. 2, p209)

#### The Close of Probation – Time of End

One of the major themes of Revelation has to do with this probationary time. The angel describes to John the close of this probationary time at the very end, in chapter 22. "He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still. And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be (Revelation 22:11, 12)." This close of probation takes place at the end of the sounding of the seventh trumpet and the beginning of the falling of the seven last plagues. Recall that no one could go into the sanctuary till the seven last plagues were fulfilled. (Revelation 15:8) In other words, there was no intercession any more, Jesus had left the Most Holy Place. That probation closes when you die is also true, for "it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment (Hebrews 9:27)." We only have one lifetime in which to get ready, one more breath in which to praise or rebel against God.






# Are the Plagues and Judgments of God real or figurative?

- 1. God told Noah that He would give the antediluvian world 120 years to repent and return to Him, after that a Universal Flood happened. The flood destroyed them all away.
- 2. When Pharaoh refused to let Israel go, ten literal plagues fell upon the land of Egypt.
- 3. When Israel turned its back on God and worshipped idols, pagan countries destroyed them.
- 4. When Israel and Judah no longer followed the God of their fathers, Assyria and Babylon destroyed Israel and led them into literal and physical captivity for seventy years.
- 5. When Israel's time of probation—70 weeks of years, or 490 years—was given them to function as the chosen people of God, they rejected Jesus and His messengers, and they were literally destroyed as a nation in A.D. 70 by Titus, in the siege of Jerusalem.
- 6. When the Christian church left the apostolic teachings of Jesus and the disciples, cast down the once-for-all sacrifice of Jesus in favour of the mass, and reinstituted the Aaronic priesthood in place of the high priestly ministry of Jesus (Judges 5:8), then was there war in the gates. The barbarian invasions of the Western Christian Roman Empire and the Muslim invasions on the Eastern Christian Roman Empire were as harsh as they were literal.
- 7. One can conclude that those who reject the seal of God and worship the beast and the image of the beast could receive a literal punishment (Seven Last Plagues).



# Five Truths About the Wrath of God


We live in a day where we have set ourselves as the judge and God's character is on trial. "How can hell be just?" "Why would God command the Israelites to destroy the Canaanites?" "Why does God always seem so angry?"



# 1. God's wrath is just

If thou sayest, Behold, we knew it not; doth not he that pondereth the heart consider it? and he that keepeth thy soul, doth not he know it? and shall not he render to every man according to his works? – Proverbs 24:12

But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God; - Romans 2:5





# 2. God's wrath is to be feared

God's wrath is to be feared because all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23). God's wrath is to be feared because we are justly condemned sinners apart from Christ (Romans 5:1). God's wrath is to be feared because he is powerful enough to do what he promises (Jeremiah 32:17). God's wrath is to be feared because God promises eternal punishment apart from Christ (Matthew 25:46).

IMMORALITY, IMPURITY, PASSION, EVIL DESIRE, GREED = IDOLATRY

For it is because of these things that the wrath of God will come upon the sons of disobedience. Colossians 3:6



# 3. God's wrath is consistent in the Old and New Testaments

Behold, the whirlwind of the LORD goeth forth with fury, a continuing whirlwind: it shall fall with pain upon the head of the wicked. – Jeremiah 30:23

God *is* jealous, and the LORD revengeth; the LORD revengeth, and *is* furious; the LORD will take vengeance on his adversaries, and he reserveth *wrath* for his enemies.

- Nahum 1:2

And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. – Revelation 19:15



### 4. God's wrath is his love in action against sin

# IS GOD ONLY A GOD OF LOVE, OR IS HE ALSO A GOD OF WRATH?

Let's consider the concept of the wrath of God. The reason we need to do that is because I have discovered that most Christians, if not most pastors, do not believe in the wrath of God.

If any mention is made of God's wrath, there is usually an immediate and vehement response that God is a God of love, grace and mercy. And if you point to the wrath of God in the Hebrew Scriptures...



Everyone knows John 3:16; few seem to be aware of John 3:36, taken from a sermon of John the Baptist: "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son will not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."



### 5. God's wrath is satisfied in Christ

#### Here we have the ultimate good news:

"Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" (1 Timothy 1:15).

Because of Christ, God can rightly call sinners justified (Romans 3:26).

God has done what we could not do, and he has done what we didn't deserve.

Charles Wesley rightly exulted in this good news:
And can it be that I should gain
An interest in the Saviour's blood?
Died he for me, who caused his pain!
For me, who him to death pursued?
Amazing love! How can it be
That thou, my God, shouldst die for me?





#### The four heptads or the four "sevens" in Revelation

- The Seven Churches time periods begin at Pentecost AD 31 and end at the close of the Laodicean period, which would be the Second Coming.
- 2. The Seven Seals time periods begin when Jesus takes the scroll and begins His reign at Pentecost, AD 31, when the Holy Spirit is poured out on the earth upon the waiting disciples. The sixth seal ends with the Second Coming and the seventh seal the short period of silence in the heavens.
- 3. The Seven Trumpets time periods begin with the Mediatorial work of Jesus at the golden altar in the Holy Place in AD 31. The seventh trumpet ends when the mystery of God is finished on the earth; (10:7), the Seal of God having been placed on all those that love Jesus and the Mark of the Beast having been placed on all those who despise Jesus and worship Satan.
- 4. AND THEN AFTER THIS, thy "wrath" is come, this wrath of God, this judgment of God on evil, the Seven Last Plagues.



# The purpose of the seven last plagues

The saints under the altar in the 5<sup>th</sup> seal (Revelation 5:9) are asking when God is going to "avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth"? The psalmist provides the answer: "O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, shew thyself. Lift up thyself, thou judge of the earth: render a reward to the proud. LORD, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked triumph? How long shall they utter and speak hard things? And all the workers of iniquity boast themselves? They break in pieces thy people, O LORD, and afflict thine heritage. They slay the widow and the stranger, and murder the fatherless (Psalm 94:1-6)." See also Isaiah 63:1-6; Psalm 149:1-9; Jeremiah 51:6; Romans 12:19; and Hebrews 10:30.



# The purpose of the seven last plagues

These various passages speak of the right of vengeance that belongs to the sovereign Lord. His is the right to subdue and punish rebellious people and nations. Some texts refer to the final judgment of the wicked. God has given Satan this incredibly long time, by human standards (6000+ years), to show himself and his methods. But God will take vengeance upon those who have killed His people. Revelation 18:6 reveals that Babylon

will be rewarded doubly for what she did to those who stood true for God.



# The purpose of the seven last plagues

When is this? Is this avenging by God described in Revelation15:1, when we see seven angels, "having the seven last plagues, for in them is filled up the wrath of God"? Here is the time when Asaph, in Psalm 73:3-17, says he was envious at the prosperity of the wicked. Then he "...went into the sanctuary of God; then understood their end." He saw the seven angels with the seven vials of the wrath of God in the sanctuary. Notice in Revelation 15:6, that the seven angels came OUT of the temple just before they began to pour out the vials.






At this point, God seems to want to delay getting into the final judgment. He takes no pleasure in punishing sinners and is reluctant to close the opportunity to repent.

### The Gospel!

### The Gospel!

You shall not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flies by day; nor for the pestilence that walks in darkness; nor for the destruction that wastes at noonday.

# Who Are The Plagues Against?


- Revelation 16:1 & 2

## A Vital Point to Remember



  - The saints are commandment keepers \

# Winston Churchill Former Prime Minister of England


- Made this statement at the close of World War 2, after the atomic bomb had been dropped on Japan.

# The Last Battle The Battle of Armageddon

- Since 1944 or the close of W.W. II there have been over 125 more wars.
- Armageddon will be the last and different
- At Armageddon God intervenes in behalf of his persecuted people
- God delivers his people and punishes the wicked through the Battle of Armageddon.
- Then Jesus comes in the clouds of heaven and brings the world to an end






 Each plague gets more severe and continues as other plagues come upon the scene.

All the judgments upon men, prior to the close of probation, have been mingled with mercy. The pleading blood of Christ has shielded the sinner from receiving the full measure of his guilt; but in the final judgment, wrath is poured out unmixed with mercy. In that day, multitudes will desire the shelter of God's mercy which they have so long despised.






'Behold, the days come, saith the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord: and they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the Lord, and shall not find it.' - Amos 8:11, 12."





"While Jesus had been standing between God and guilty man, a restraint was upon the people; but when He stepped out from between man and the Father, the restraint was removed and Satan had entire control of the finally impenitent. It was impossible for the plagues to be poured out while Jesus officiated in the sanctuary; but as His work there is finished, and His intercession closes, there is nothing to stay the wrath of God, and it breaks with fury upon the shelterless head of the guilty sinner, who has slighted salvation and hated reproof. In that fearful time, after the close of Jesus' mediation, the saints were living in the sight of a holy God without an intercessor. Every case was decided, every jewel numbered." E.G.W. (Early Writings, p. 280)



Chapter 15 opens with a quick glance at seven angels carrying the seven last plagues.

But then it quickly shows us again a picture of the joyful ones around the throne who have won the victory over evil through the power of Jesus.



Then we see the temple opened and out of it comes seven angels. They are dressed in white linen, which shows they are pure and holy, like Jesus. One of the four beasts gives each angel a golden vial, which is 'full of the wrath of God'.



## What two punishments are given to the wicked?

- "...the wrath of God." -Revelation 15:1
- Is for those who receive the mark of the beast (Revelation 16:2)
- "...tormented with fire and brimstone..." -Revelation 14:10
- The fire and brimstone is for all lost sinners including those who receive the Mark of the Beast at 2<sup>nd</sup> Resurrection.







"And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God. And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God. And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, **Great and marvelous are thy works, Lord** God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints." Revelation 15:1-3.



"Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest."

"And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened:" -Revelation 15:5








And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles. – Revelation 15:6



It is necessary for the good of others that these terrible plagues have to fall on the wicked world. There are several reasons for them. One is that these wicked ones are determined to murder all of God's faithful children. He will not allow this to happen.





Another reason is to show to the universe that nothing God could do would ever get these rebels to change. No matter what, they will curse God and still go on being wicked and cruel.



The last verse of chapter 15 tells us that no body is in the heavenly sanctuary at this time. Probation has closed forever on the earth. The mercy and love, which for all the years of earth's history has been poured out for people through Jesus, has finally ended. The world is left to its chosen ways, while the faithful ones are surrounded by heavenly angels and protected.



Jesus, our Great High Priest is still pleading at present in the Most Holy Place of the heavenly Sanctuary. The Day of Atonement judgment is going on. How soon All of our names will come up, we don't know but signs are all around us that the mercy of God will soon cease and our probation will close forever.



We have to want that sinless life - we have to choose to have it - if we want to give Jesus lip service while we still cling to our darling sins - we will be lost! Those who are saved at last will hate sin just as God hates it - they will have rejected all of its so called pleasures and see it for the hideous, cruel thing that it is.





# 1st Plague

"And the first angel went, and poured out his vial upon the, earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image." Revelation 16:2



Can you imagine sores all over your body! Notice, these gnawing, painful sores will afflict only those who have the mark of the beast and worship his image. What will it be like when this happens.

















The first vial plague is poured out on the earth and a "grievous sore" (draining boils) come upon those who "have the mark of the beast and worship his image." The Greek word here means "draining boils", the same word used in Exodus 9:10, 11 to describe the boils that came upon the Egyptians where Moses threw ashes in the air in front of Pharaoh and sores broke out on man and beast. Look at Deuteronomy 28:35 where the Lord would smite them with sores from the head to the foot because of their apostasy. Job experienced these same "boils," as did Lazarus in Luke 16:19-31.



Can you picture the evening news telling the shocking story of this gross epidemic? People by the thousands who have received the "mark" for the purpose of saving their jobs and comforts of life now find that their comfort is gone.



Instead of causing them to repent, and pray to God for forgiveness, these terrible sores only cause them to "blaspheme God" and "gnaw their tongues for pain." God knows that if He gave them a 100's of years more, they wouldn't, change. When the plagues begin to fall, you'll know that every case is decided for eternity. Medical science will be helpless then. Can you picture doctors' offices and drug stores packed with shouting, angry, crying victims? What medicine will relieve the throbbing, biting, pain?



Not everyone will get these awful sores. Those who so lately have been persecuted and mocked, are now safe. Angels of God protect them. They have loved and been obedient to their Lord even unto death, and now Jesus is very close to them. Though they'll be sentenced to death, God's people will not die. Jesus will interpose to save them. While the wicked are perishing with pestilence and famine, God's people are sheltered in the shadow of His hand.





# The Good News is... Psalms 91:3-10

Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.





## REVELATION 16:3 ) K J V "And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea."



All of a sudden the news breaks - the ocean waters have turned to blood! Under the third plague the rivers also turn to blood. The word "soul" here means' "living creature." Have you ever seen the blood of a dead man? It putrefies and coagulates into a jelly mass. Those who have hated God's people have tried to shed their blood and now they are given blood to drink.





The second vial plague is poured out on the sea and it turns to blood. Without oxygen in the water, everything in the sea died; a stinking, putrefying mess. The sea is no longer useful for commercial travel and no longer useful for food. The loss of the oceans in their natural cycle of watering the earth creates havoc with the ecosystem.




### The Good News is... Isaiah 33:16

He shall dwell on high: his place of defence shall be the munitions of rocks: bread shall be given him; his waters shall be sure.









Notice what the angel says here, who has seen the entire history of the world and the misery and killing and persecutions Satan, his former colleague, has caused: "And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus. For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and thou hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy." - Revelation 16:5-6

The third vial plague is poured out on the rivers and fountains of waters and they become blood. People will hike to the mountains and streams looking for fresh water. They can dig where they will, go where they will, they will find nothing but blood to drink.

All the beings of the universe as well as the angels declare that they deserve just what they are getting. One voice is the angel from heaven and the other voice comes from the altar which represents the saved on earth. As terrible as these judgments are, they are righteous! You see, God is not an arbitrary tyrant. He moves ahead with His judgments only as fast as his created children are able to understand them and approve of them.





## The Good News is... Isaiah 41:17-18

When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for thirst, I the LORD will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them. I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water.

and they repented not to give him glory."




The fourth vial plague is poured out on the sun. This life-sustaining sun, necessary for all plant and animal life, becomes hotter than it ever has before. Is this global warming? No. God gives power to the sun to scorch men with fire.





The fourth plague causes the sun to become so hot that it scorches people! This is also a very fair judgment because these people are exalting sun-worship and seeking to force all to worship the Sunday— so God gives them what they want—lots of sun! Horrible pain is now experienced by the wicked. The combination of scorching heat and raw sores is excruciating. Miracles will abound, like in Moses day; some from God, some from Satan. The wicked will not realize that the devil has counterfeited the gifts of the Spirit. Many who have worked miracles and done wonderful works, have trampled on God's Sabbath and persecuted those who honored it. They've felt secure in God's favor. But now their rage is great.





Air-conditioners will not be able to cope with the intense heat. The buildings will be like ovens. For the wicked, there'll be no relief anywhere. This plague is perfectly suited to the sin of the people. They have honored the "day of the sun" according to the traditions of men - and now God gives them sun! The New English Bible says that men were "fearfully burned" during the fourth plague.

In that day, many will long for the shelter of God's mercy which they have so long despised.





God's people will still be hiding in desolate places, but He who provided food for Elijah in the wilderness will care for them. While the wicked are dying from the pestilence, angels will shield God's faithful people and supply their wants. God's promise is:

"When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for thirst, I the lord will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them." Isaiah 33:15,16; 41:17.

While the disobedient are shrieking in pain, reeking with sweat, and their parched throats are raw for thirst, God's promise to His people is: 'The Lord is thy keeper: the Lord is thy shade upon thy right hand. The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night." Psalms 121:5-7.





### The Good News is... Psalms 121

Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep. The LORD is thy keeper: the LORD is thy shade upon thy right hand. The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night.







The fifth brings dense darkness to the seat of the Beast—his kingdom is full of darkness. For centuries Rome has poured out spiritual darkness onto the world, now they find themselves in actual darkness.

Can you imagine that! In choosing to honor the beast and receive his "mark" instead of honoring God and His "seal," the people have chosen darkness. Now again, God gives them what they've chosen.


I think the human mind is inadequate to conceive of the horror that will engulf all society. People of high society, the rich, men of science, and the ignorant masses will be paralyzed with pain, hate, and panic. Society will be utter chaos! Of these scourges the Bible says: - Revelation 18:17-19





### 5<sup>th</sup> Plague - Darkness

"The land mourneth; ... because the harvest of the field is perished ... All the trees of the field are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men." "How do the beasts groan! The herds of cattle are perplexed, because they have no pasture." Joel 1:10-12; 17-20.





Oh, if they had only responded to God's great kindness. His arms have been stretched out in love. Now it's too late, The disobedient have decreed that those who have received God's seal cannot buy or sell. Now they themselves are starving with famine and groping in utter darkness. This supernatural darkness is a fit symbol of the gross darkness that has come upon the minds of those who have turned away from the light of truth.



God's people are still hiding out. They've weeks ago lost their jobs, homes, and fled for their lives before insane men urged on by the religious leaders and evil angels. They've given up all for- Christ. They've seen the wicked perishing while angels of God provided food for them. To the obedient God's promise is given: "Bread shall be given him; his waters shall be sure.





By the fifth plague, the whole wicked world is really angry. They've decided that those who honor God's Sabbath of the Bible are the cause of the horrible convulsions of nature and they determine to blot them from the earth!

When the protection of human laws shall be withdrawn from those who honour the law of God, there will be, in different lands, a simultaneous movement for their destruction. As the time appointed in the decree draws near, the people will conspire to root out the hated sect. It will be determined to strike in one night a decisive blow, which shall utterly silence the voice of dissent and reproof." {GC 635.1}

The date has been set to strike one stunning blow that will wipe the hated sect from the face of the earth. At midnight the death decree goes into effect. At midnight, - the Mighty God of heaven will interpose to save His people. Watch what happens.



"The people of God-some in prison cells, some hidden in solitary retreats in the forests and the mountains-still plead for divine protection, while in every quarter companies of armed men, urged on by hosts of evil angels, are preparing for the work of death. It is now, in the hour of utmost extremity that the God of Israel will interpose for the deliverance of His chosen. Saith the Lord; "Ye shall have a song, as in the night when a holy solemnity is kept; and gladness of heart, as when one goeth . . . to come into the mountain of the Lord, to the Mighty One of Israel. And the Lord shall cause His glorious voice to be heard, and shall show the lighting down of His arm, with the indignation of His anger, and with the flame of a devouring fire, with scattering, and tempest, and hailstones." Isaiah 30:29, 30." {GC 635.2}




"With shouts of triumph, jeering, and imprecation, throngs of evil men are about to rush upon their prey, when, lo, a dense blackness, deeper than the darkness of the night, falls upon the earth. Then a rainbow, shining with the glory from the throne of God, spans the heavens and seems to encircle each praying company. The angry multitudes are suddenly arrested. Their mocking cries die away. The objects of their murderous rage are forgotten. With fearful forebodings they gaze upon the symbol of God's covenant and long to be shielded from its overpowering brightness." {GC 635.3}



## 5<sup>th</sup> Plague - Darkness

"By the people of God a voice, clear and melodious, is heard, saying, "Look up," and lifting their eyes to the heavens, they behold the bow of promise. The black, angry clouds that covered the firmament are parted, and like Stephen they look up steadfastly into heaven and see the glory of God and the Son of man seated upon His throne. In His divine form they discern the marks of His humiliation; and from His lips they hear the request presented before His Father and the holy angels: "I will that they also, whom Thou hast given Me, be with Me where I am." John 17:24. Again a voice, musical and triumphant, is heard, saying: "They come! They come! Holy, harmless, and undefiled. They have kept the word of My patience; they shall walk among the angels;" and the pale, quivering lips of those who have held fast their faith utter a shout of victory." {GC 636.1}



### 5<sup>th</sup> Plague - Darkness

"It is at midnight that God manifests His power for the deliverance of His people. The sun appears, shining in its strength. Signs and wonders follow in quick succession. The wicked look with terror and amazement upon the scene, while the righteous behold with solemn joy the tokens of their deliverance. Everything in nature seems turned out of its course. The streams cease to flow. Dark, heavy clouds come up and clash against each other. In the midst of the angry heavens is one clear space of indescribable glory, whence comes the voice of God like the sound of many waters, saying: "It is done." Revelation 16:17." {GC 636.2}






### 6th Plague – 3 Unclean Sprits like Frogs















"Through the two great errors, the immortality of the soul and Sunday sacredness, Satan will bring the people under his deceptions. While the former lays the foundation of spiritualism, the latter creates a bond of sympathy with Rome. The Protestants of the United States will be foremost in stretching their hands across the gulf to grasp the hand of spiritualism; they will reach over the abyss to clasp hands with the Roman power; and under the influence of this threefold union, this country will follow in the steps of Rome in trampling on the rights of conscience".

— The Great Controversy, p. 588.



The sixth plague talks about the dying up of a river. When real Babylon was conquered, the river that flowed through the city was dried up so the soldiers came into the city in the riverbed. So this shows us that spiritual Babylon is about to fall, as the 'waters', which represent the people of the world who support it, turn away from supporting it, and start to fight against it. This prepares the way for Jesus coming, represented as the 'Kings of the East'.





Always remember when you read the prophecies that they do not follow through in order like a story, the 6th plague of course does follow the fifth but some things referred to here are reaching a climax that began long before. These two verses, although they are mentioned in the time of the 6th plague when they reach their climax, they actually begin happening long before that. They are happening now, as Satan uses his miracles and tricks to fool people into disobey God and seeking to force everyone to also disobey Him.



Notice the 3 symbols; The Dragon—spiritualism; the Beast—Papal Rome; the False Prophet—Apostate Protestantism.

Satan gets them to join together and he gets the kings and mighty men of the earth to join in too—how? By performing miracles and wonders that get people believing the lies he is telling them. Only people who know and believe the Bible will not be tricked.



"Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame." Revelation 16:15



It is most interesting that Jesus inserts this warning thought here right during this period of final events. When this time actually comes it is then too late to get the Garment of Christ's righteousness and put it on. If we are not to be naked in that terrible day, and all the universe see our shame, we must accept the garment now and co-operate with Jesus as He works to perfect our characters to be like His. If we think we are 'good enough' as 'good as the next guy' and our own good works are enough to take us to heaven and we don't feel the need to repent and plead with Jesus now to take all the sin out of our lives and make us pure; then in that day, we will be exposed to all for what we are, hypocrites.

"And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon." Revelation 16:16.

It is this gathering of all the powers of earth together for the purpose of fighting against God's law and His people that is called the Battle of Armageddon. There have been many funny things taught about this subject, but what it means is this time when these powers seek to force everybody to break God's law. It is not a particular place or a literal battle between powers of earth.



# The Sixth Plague

The word "Armageddon" is made of two Hebrew words "Har" and "Megidon." This is not just some local battle fought in the Valley of Megido as some have said. The word "Har" means "mountain." "Armageddon" is the symbolic word Jesus uses here to denote the great universal battle where the wicked turn against God and His faithful people. This is a world-wide battle. The national Sunday law of the U.S. has spread to all the nations of the world. The Universal law seeks to, in one day, strike a decisive blow that will wipe the hated sect from the face of the earth.



When the great corrupt, Christian coalition of the world comes to the place where it causes (amid miracles and Satanic delusion) the leaders ("kings of the earth") to decree that those who will not go along with the Sunday law should be put to death, it brings the world to the place of sealing it's own doom.



# The Sixth Plague

The people of God, some still in prison, some hidden in forests and mountains - still plead for God's protection, while companies of armed men, hurried on by evil angels, are preparing to execute the death sentence. It's now - in the darkest hour, that the God of Israel will interpose to deliver His faithful people.



### Good news is.... Psalms 46:1





"And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. And there were voices, and thunders and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake and so great. And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. 






### The Good News is... Isaiah 54:14-17

No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD.





Here's where the spirits of devils, by their miracles, prepare the rulers and people of the world and "gather them together" to fight against God and His people. This is the global-conflict. This is the battle of Armageddon. It's earth's final battle between good and evil. All have taken sides. The wicked are in the majority and seemingly have great advantage - like David against Goliath.

Here we see that Great Babylon, made out of these 3 parts, which Satan has worked so hard to bring together, quickly falls apart again and all the parts fight against each other.

The seventh plague takes place as Jesus comes back to get His faithful people. A terrible hailstorm with huge chunks of ice comes and smashes all the proud cities of earth.





Everything in nature goes haywire. The mountains shake like reeds in the wind. The wicked are paralyzed with abject terror and look with amazement upon the scene, while the obedient watch with solemn joy at the signs of their deliverance. Ragged rocks are hurled in every direction. The sea is lashed into fury. The earth heaves and swells. Its surface is breaking apart. Mountain chains sink. Islands disappear. Wicked cities that have become like Sodom are swallowed up by tidal waves. Great hailstones, each "about the weight of a talent" are wreaking havoc. A talent is about 63 pounds. You can see that these, like cannon balls, will beat the wicked cities to a pulp.






Splendid mansions erected by the rich with money embezzled from the poor are dashed to pieces before their eyes. Prison walls tumble down, and God's humble people, who have been held in bondage for their faith are set free.

It's impossible to describe the horror and despair of those who have trampled on God's requirements. The enemies of God's law, from the ministers down, have a new conception of what is truth. Too late, they see the true nature of the counterfeit Sabbath that the Roman church has brought in and the shaky foundation they've been building on. Many now see that they're lost. They've chosen the easy, popular way - and have received the mark of the beast. They've followed the religious leaders instead of the plain word of God. They've been led to believe that the majority couldn't be wrong. Now they turn on their ministers and bitterly reproach them for their sorry state.





The global conflict has prepared the way for the coming of Christ and His mighty host of angels during the last of the plagues, There appears in the sky a cloud which betokens the coming of the "King of Kings and Lord of Lords." In solemn silence God's people gaze upon it as it draws nearer and nearer to' the earth. Brighter and brighter it becomes, and more glorious, until it's a great white cloud, its glory like consuming fire. Jesus rides forth as a mighty conqueror. "And the armies which were in heaven" follow Him. Revelation 19:11,14. The whole heaven seems filled with dazzling forms - "ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands."



No pen can describe it. No human mind is adequate to imagine the fantastic and holy scene. As the living cloud comes still nearer, every eye beholds the lovely Jesus. There's no crown of thorns on that holy brow, but now a crown of glory rests upon His sacred head. His face outshines the dazzling brightness of the sun.

As the King of Glory descends on the cloud amid terrific majesty, and wrapped in flaming fire, the earth trembles. The ground heaves and swells and the very mountains move from their foundations.







"Our God shall come, and shall not keep silence: a fire shall devour before Him, and it shall be very tempestuous round about Him. He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth,, that He may judge His people." Psalms 50:3,4




The jokes have stopped. Cursing, lying,, lips are now silent. In the middle of their terror the wicked hear the voices of God's people joyfully exclaiming.

Plague contained in the vial

A malignant sore strikes men.

Sea turned to blood.

Springs of water turned to blood.

The sun scorches men.

Deep darkness upon the world.

Drying up of the river Euphrates.

Terrible earthquake and great hail at the return of Jesus.

Specific sin punished by this plague

Contempt for God's commandments.

Choosing the mark of the beast in order to maintain material security.



The swarms of flies did not invade the land of Goshen, where the Hebrews were dwelling (see Exodus 8:22).

The livestock of Israel did not die (see Exodus 9:4).

The boils and sores struck only the Egyptians (see Exodus 9:11).

The hail spared Goshen, where Israel lived (see Exodus 9:26).

The locust invasion struck only the houses of the Egyptians (see Exodus 10:6).

No darkness in the Hebrews' dwellings (see Exodus 10:23).

No firstborn died in all the houses which were marked with the blood of a sacrified lamb (see Exodus 11:4-7; 12:12,13).






# The seven last plagues – God's wrath


