



Health Snippet - Sunshine:

Exposure to sunlight increases the brain's release of the hormone Serotonin which boosts the mood & calmness. At night, darkness triggers the brain to make the hormone Melatonin which helps you to sleep. Low levels of Serotonin: risk of major depression with seasonal pattern (formerly known as Seasonal Affective Disorder or SAD). Exposure to the ultraviolet-B radiation in the sun's rays causes a person's skin to create vitamin D. According to one study from 2008, in a 30-minute period while exposing arms & legs, make the following vitamin D levels:

- 50,000 international units in most Caucasian people
- 20,000 to 30,000 IUs in **tanned people**
- 8,000 to 10,000 IUs in dark skinned people
 While there are a lot of good reasons to get sun, the sun emits ultraviolet (UV) radiation, which can penetrate the skin and damage cell DNA. This can lead to skin cancer.
 According to WHO, getting 5 to 15 minutes of sunlight on arms, hands, and face 2-3 times a week is enough. Note, wear sunscreen or clothing won't result in Vt D production



The Three Enemies of 1st Elijah







Unlawful Relationship Between Jezebel and Ahab


And Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the LORD above all that were before him. And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, that he took to wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Zidonians, and went and served Baal, and worshipped him. And he reared up an altar for Baal in the house of Baal, which he had built in Samaria. And Ahab made a grove; and Ahab did more to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger than all the kings of Israel that were before him. - 1 Kings 16:30-33





Jezebel Pulls the Strings

8 So she wrote letters in Ahab's name, and sealed them with his seal, and sent the letters unto the elders and to the nobles that were in his city, dwelling with Naboth. **9** And she wrote in the letters, saying, Proclaim a fast, and set Naboth on high among the people: 10 And set two men, sons of Belial, before him, to bear witness against him, saying, Thou didst blaspheme God and the king. And then carry him out, and stone him, that he may die. - 1 Kings 21



Ahab – Weak King in moral power

But there was none like unto Ahab, which did sell himself to work wickedness in the sight of the LORD, whom Jezebel his wife stirred up.

– 1 Kings 21:25

"Ahab was weak in moral power. His union by marriage with an idolatrous woman of decided character and positive temperament resulted disastrously both to himself and to the nation. Unprincipled, and with no high standard of right doing, his character was easily moulded by the determined spirit of Jezebel." PK 115



Results in Amalgamation

And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word. – 1 Kings 18:21

Jezebel imposed a syncretistic religion upon Israel—a mixture or amalgamation of Yahweh worship and Baal worship.








3 Fold Alliance Caused Israel to Sin


The reason for the calamities


The drought a judgment from Jehovah

Yet notwithstanding these evidences of God's power, Israel repented not, nor learned the lesson that God would have them learn. They did not see that He who created nature controls her laws, and can make of them instruments of blessing or of destruction. Proud hearted, enamored of their false worship, they were unwilling to humble themselves under the mighty hand of God, and they began to cast about for some other cause to which to attribute their sufferings. Jezebel utterly refused to recognize the drought as a judgment from Jehovah. Unyielding in her determination to defy the God of heaven, she, with nearly the whole of Israel, united in denouncing Elijah as the cause of all their misery. Had he not borne testimony against their forms of worship? If only he could be put out of the way, she argued, the anger of their gods would be appeased, and their troubles would end. {PK 126.1}




God preserves and protects Elijah

Urged on by the queen, Ahab instituted a most diligent search for the hiding place of the prophet. To the surrounding nations, far and near, he sent messengers to seek for the man whom he hated, yet feared; and in his anxiety to make the search as thorough as possible, he required of these kingdoms and nations an oath that they knew nothing of the whereabouts of the prophet. But the search was in vain. The prophet was safe from the malice of the king whose sins had brought upon the land the denunciation of an offended God. Failing in her efforts against Elijah, Jezebel determined to avenge herself by slaying all the prophets of Jehovah in Israel. Not one should be left alive. The infuriated woman carried out her purpose in the massacre of many of God's servants. Not all, however, perished. Obadiah, the governor of Ahab's house, yet faithful to God, "took an hundred prophets," and at the risk of his own life, "hid them by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water." 1 Kings 18:4. PK p126



The people were influenced to seek Elijah and the prophets to kill them

10 And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: for the children of Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars, and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, even I only, am left; and they seek my life, to take it away. - 1 Kings 19






Three fold union seeks Elijah to kill him

I Kings 17:1-7: Elijah fled to the wilderness and was sustained by God


"For three years the messenger of woe was sought for in city after city and nation after nation. At the mandate of Ahab, many rulers had given their oath of honor that the strange prophet could not be found in their dominions. Yet the search was continued, for Jezebel and the prophets of Baal hated Elijah with a deadly hatred, and they spared no effort to bring him within reach of their power. And still there was no rain." PK 137



God is with Elijah – He is not alone

"And Elijah came to all the people, and said, "How long will you falter between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow Him; but if Baal, follow him." But the people answered him not a word."


"Facing King Ahab and the false prophets, and surrounded by the assembled hosts of Israel, Elijah stands, the only one who has appeared to vindicate the honour of Jehovah. He whom the whole kingdom has charged with its weight of woe is now before them, apparently defenceless in the presence of the monarch of Israel, the prophets of Baal, the men of war, and the surrounding thousands. But Elijah is not alone. Above and around him are the protecting hosts of heaven, angels that excel in strength." PK 147



Elijah goes through Tribulation before Translation

I Kings 18:4: Elijah and the prophets are on earth during the tribulation and the death decree. He is translated after the death decree, flight to the wilderness and the tribulation (II Kings 2:11, 12). God's end time Elijah will go through the tribulation and the death decree, they will not be raptured before.

I Kings 18:21: Elijah calls for a clear cut decision. No one could stand on the fence. Only two groups would be left after the test on Mount Carmel. No power in the message without the fire.





Elijah is a restorer, not an innovator

Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again. – 1 Kings 18:37

The mission of Elijah is to God's people who have been deceived by the triple alliance. It is to those who claim to serve the true God and not to the pagan nations. Elijah was not an innovator who brought new truth but rather a restorer of true worship, true sacrifice and the commandments of God.



Elijah mocks at 12th hour – Sun right above

Baal is Sun god - it was right overhead

26 And they took the bullock which was given them, and they dressed it, and called on the name of Baal from morning even until noon, saying, O Baal, hear us. But there was no voice, nor any that answered. And they leaped upon the altar which was made. 27 And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he is a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, or peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked. – 1 Kings 18



The worship style of the prophets of Baal

28 And they cried aloud, and cut themselves after their manner with knives and lancets, till the blood gushed out upon them. 29 And it came to pass, when midday was past, and they prophesied until the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that there was neither voice, nor any to answer, nor any that regarded. - 1 Kings 18



Elijah repaired the altar of the Lord

And Elijah said unto all the people, Come near unto me. And all the people came near unto him. And he repaired the altar of the LORD that was broken down. – 1 Kings 18:30

Elijah was restoring the covenant of the Lord which had been broken. The covenant includes two things: Covenant law and covenant sacrifice.




Elijah instructs to pour water on Sacrifice

33 And he put the wood in order, and cut the bullock in pieces, and laid him on the wood, and said, Fill four barrels with water, and pour it on the burnt sacrifice, and on the wood. 34 And he said, Do it the second time. And they did it the second time. And he said, Do it the third time. And they did it the third time. 35 And the water ran round about the

altar; and he filled the trench also

with water. - 1 Kings 18



Elijah now at 3pm - time of evening sacrifice

36 And it came to pass at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou art God in Israel, and that I am thy servant, and that I have done all these things at thy word.

37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again. – 1 Kings 18




Elijah rebuked false worship to the sun god and restored true worship to the creator God

O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker. – Psalms 95:6

6 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,

7 Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. – Revelation 14




The fire from heaven with the message brings conviction. Mt. Carmel shone with the glory of God.

38 Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that *was* in the trench.

39 And when all the people saw *it*, they fell on their faces: and they said, The LORD, he *is* the God; the LORD, he *is* the God.1 Kings 18


"No sooner is the prayer of Elijah ended than flames of fire, like brilliant flashes of lightning, descend from heaven upon the prepared altar, consuming the sacrifice, licking up the water in the trench, and consuming even the stones of the altar. The brilliancy of the blaze illumines the mountain and dazzles the eyes of the multitude. In the valleys below, where many are watching in anxious suspense the movements of those above, the descent of fire is clearly seen, and all are amazed at the sight. It resembles the pillar of fire which at the Red Sea separated the children of Israel from the Egyptian host." PK pp. 152, 153



1. All False Prophets killed

40 And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there. 1 Kings 18

"The priests of Baal witness with consternation the wonderful revelation of Jehovah's power. Yet even in their discomfiture and in the presence of divine glory, they refuse to repent of their evildoing. They would still remain the prophets of Baal. Thus they showed themselves ripe for destruction. That repentant Israel may be protected from the allurements of those who have taught them to worship Baal, Elijah is directed by the Lord to destroy these false teachers. The anger of the people has already been aroused against the leaders in transgression; and when Elijah gives the command, "Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape," they are ready to obey. They seize the priests, and take them to the brook Kishon, and there, before the close of the day that marked the beginning of decided reform, the ministers of Baal are slain. Not one is permitted to live. PK 153, 154



Elijah Prays – God Answers

17 Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months.


18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit. – James 5



Jezebel (Harlot) is angry - passes Death Decree

- 1 And Ahab told Jezebel all that Elijah had done, and withal how he had slain all the prophets with the sword.
- 2 Then Jezebel sent a messenger unto Elijah, saying, So let the gods do to me, and more also, if I make not thy life as the life of one of them by to morrow about this time.

 1 Kings 19



Elijah afraid of the Harlot Women

3 And when he saw *that*, he arose, and went for his life, and came to Beersheba, which belongeth to Judah, and left his servant there. 4 But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a juniper tree: and he requested for himself that he might die; and said, It is enough; now, O LORD, take away my life; for I am not better than my fathers.

2. King Ahab Killed

34 And a *certain* man drew a bow at a venture, and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: wherefore he said unto the driver of his chariot, Turn thine hand, and carry me out of the host; for I am wounded.

37 So the king died, and was brought to


37 So the king died, and was brought to Samaria; and they buried the king in Samaria.

3. Harlot Woman Killed - Jezebel

- And he lifted up his face to the window, and said, Who *is* on my side? who? And there looked out to him two *or* three eunuchs.
- And he said, Throw her down. So they threw her down: and *some* of her blood was sprinkled on the wall, and on the horses: and he trode her under foot.
- And when he was come in, he did eat and drink, and said, Go, see now this cursed *woman*, and bury her: for she *is* a king's daughter.
- And they went to bury her: but they found no more of her than the skull, and the feet, and the palms of *her* hands.
- Wherefore they came again, and told him. And he said, This *is* the word of the LORD, which he spake by his servant Elijah the Tishbite, saying, In the portion of Jezreel shall dogs eat the flesh of Jezebel:
- And the carcase of Jezebel shall be as dung upon the face of the field in the portion of Jezreel; *so* that they shall not say, This *is* Jezebel. 2 Kings 9



Elijah taken up to heaven alive

- 11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.
- **12** And Elisha saw *it*, and he cried, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel, and the horsemen thereof. And he saw him no more: and he took hold of his own clothes, and rent them in two pieces.
- **13** He took up also the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan; 2 Kings 2


- 1. Had a Straight testimony boldly rebuked Ahab for breaking the commandments of God.

- 12. Taken to heaven alive.






The promise of the Forerunner



2nd Elijah – John the Baptist


The Old Testament ends in expectancy. The coming of the Messiah will be heralded by the arrival of Elijah the prophet.

- **13** But the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John.
- **14** And thou shalt have joy and gladness; and many shall rejoice at his birth.
- 15 For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb.
- **16** And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to the Lord their God.
- 17 And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Luke 1



Jesus testifies of John – Elijah has come

- **10** And his disciples asked him, saying, Why then say the scribes that Elias must first come?
- 11 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Elias truly shall first come, and restore all things.
- 12 But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them.
- **13** Then the disciples understood that he spake unto them of John the Baptist. Matthew 17



John was Elijah

His mission is to God's people. A different kind of apostasy: Legalism

- 11 Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.
- 12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.
- 13 For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John.
- **14** And if ye will receive *it*, this is Elias, which was for to come.
- **15** He that hath ears to hear, let him hear. Matthew 11



Make ready a people for the Lord's coming

9 But what went ye out for to see? A prophet? yea, I say unto you, and more than a prophet. **10** For this is *he*, of whom it is written, Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.






Repent of what? We are Abraham's children

Jesus as the lamb of God

Salvation only through the blood of the lamb


- **29** The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.
- **30** This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: for he was before me.
- **31** And I knew him not: but that he should be made manifest to Israel, therefore am I come baptizing with water.
- **32** And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.

Called them Vipers > Serpent > Satan

Called God's people to bear fruit that flows from repentance

- **7** But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?
- **8** Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:
- **9** And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to *our* father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham. Matthew 3



John preached a Judgement Message

A message of judgment and separation among God's people

- **10** And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.
- **11** I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:
- **12** Whose fan *is* in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire. Matt. 3



John Restores the Commandments

Preached the seventh commandment against adultery



For John had said unto Herod, It is not lawful for thee to have thy brother's wife. – Mark 6:18



Harlot woman hates John – 2nd Elijah

The adulteress woman hates John and gets him imprisoned

3 For Herod had laid hold on John, and bound him, and put *him* in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife.

4For John said unto him, It is not lawful for thee to have her.

5 And when he would have put him to death, he feared the multitude, because they counted him as a prophet.


6 But when Herod's birthday was kept, the daughter of Herodias danced before them, and pleased Herod. - Matthew 14



2nd Elijah - John killed for Woman's sake

When Elijah/John appears the threefold union appears as well

- **7** Whereupon he promised with an oath to give her whatsoever she would ask.
- **8** And she, being before instructed of her mother, said, Give me here John Baptist's head in a charger.
- **9** And the king was sorry: nevertheless for the oath's sake, and them which sat with him at meat, he commanded *it* to be given *her*.

Death decree for upholding the commandment

John died for upholding the seventh commandment and denouncing adultery of the woman with the king. For John had said unto Herod, It is not lawful for thee to have thy brother's wife. - Mark 6:18

Herodias alone could not kill John. She was restrained. She needed the aid of her daughter to manipulate the king to do her bidding. Therefore Herodias had a quarrel against him, and would have killed him; but she could not: - Mark 6:19


The king was not a menace to John. He actually respected him. It was when the daughter influenced the king to fulfil her mother's wishes that it all unravelled. For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a just man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly. – Mark 6:20

And when the daughter of the said Herodias came in, and danced, and pleased Herod and them that sat with him, the king said unto the damsel, Ask of me whatsoever thou wilt, and I will give it thee. Mark 6:22





The civil power realizes that it has been deceived by the mother and the daughter but it is a wimp. Herod was just like Ahab in the Old Testament. He had placed himself in this dilemma by marrying the harlot and by drinking wine. And the king was exceeding sorry; yet for his oath's sake, and for their sakes which sat with him, he would not reject her. – Mark 6:26

The state murders the prophet by the influence of the mother and her daughter. 



The work of John the Baptist, and the work of those who in the last days go forth in the spirit and power of Elijah to arouse the people from their apathy, are in many respects the same. His work is a type of the work that must be done in this age. Christ is to come the second time to judge the world in righteousness. The messengers of God who bear the last message of warning to be given to the world, are to prepare the way for Christ's second advent, as John prepared the way for his first advent. In this preparatory work, "every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain shall be made low; and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain;" for history is to be repeated, and once again "the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it." (SW, March 21, 1905 par. 10)




The 3rd Elijah – Apocalyptic Elijah

In the Old Testament literal Elijah was sent with a message to literal Israel. His enemy was a literal harlot, who committed literal fornication with a literal king and had literal false prophets who promoted literal worship to the literal sun god Baal.

At the end, the geographical, personal and ethnic limitations are removed and the persons in the Old Testament story become symbolic of spiritual and worldwide systems. In other words: Elijah, Israel, Jezebel, Ahab, Baal and his prophets all are symbolic of worldwide systems at the end.




- 1. Persecution of God's people by Papal Rome continued unabated and only ceased when Rome received a deadly wound.
