

Introduction

The overarching theme in the Book of **Daniel**, is the sovereignty of God over all human history, nations, and individuals. It is presented within the context of the "Great Controversy" theme—the ongoing cosmic conflict between good and evil, with God's ultimate triumph and the establishment of His eternal kingdom.

God's Sovereignty and Control: Despite the rise and fall of earthly empires, God remains in control of history. The prophecies of the various kingdoms (Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, and Rome, followed by the divided nations) all culminate in the "God of Heaven" setting up an everlasting kingdom, not built by human hands.



Introduction

The Great Controversy: The narrative and prophetic sections illustrate the struggle between God and Satan, good and evil, played out in the lives of individuals and nations. The book shows that while evil may seem to prevail temporarily, God's people will ultimately be victorious through divine intervention.

Faithfulness and Integrity Under Persecution

Persecution: The historical accounts of Daniel and his three friends (Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego) highlight the importance of unwavering loyalty and obedience to God, even in the face of intense pressure, compromise, or the threat of death. Their experiences serve as models for believers facing a hostile world.



Introduction

Prophecy for the Last Days: Adventists view Daniel as a handbook on history and prophecy, given especially for those living in the "time of the end". The prophecies are seen as a "present truth" that provides assurance of God's plan and a clear understanding of future events leading up to the second coming of Christ.

The Heavenly Sanctuary and Judgment: The book points to Jesus' ministry in the heavenly sanctuary and an eschatological (end-times) judgment, which is known as the investigative judgment. The cleansing of the sanctuary, mentioned in [Daniel 8:14](#), is a pivotal concept that judgement began in 1844 and is connected to the final events of earth's history.

- **The first test before Jesus began His ministry was appetite.** – ***1 John 2:16 Lust of the flesh***
- And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.



Daniel 5 – Belshazzar feast


Daniel

Daniel 6 – Daniel in the Lion’s den


Daniel

- Next morning He walks out of the tomb alive.



Daniel 5 – Belshazzar feast




William Miller of New England was a man of ordinary education who had been an army captain and a justice of the peace.





Daniel 10 – Jesus promises to strengthen and protect

- This chapter is an introduction to the prophecies contained in the two following chapters;
- Daniel's mourning and fasting,
- The appearance of the man by the river.
- It appears that chapters 10-12 more fully describe the vision found in Daniel 8.
- One may consider the tenth chapter is the prologue; the eleventh, the prophecy itself; and the twelfth, the epilogue.

Then he continued, "Do not be afraid, Daniel. Since the first day that you set your mind to gain understanding and to humble yourself before God, your words were heard, and I have come in response to them. Do not be afraid, O man highly esteemed," he said. "Peace! Be strong now, be strong!"

Daniel 11 – History till the end of the world

Daniel Remnant

44 But tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him: therefore he shall go forth with great fury to destroy, and utterly to make away many.



God's sealing message is the message from the east. The righteous man from the east and north is Christ. The message of Christ that comes from the east and north is the good tidings of the "Lord our righteousness," which is, of course, the three angels' messages. (Revelation 14) It is the message by which, first, the church, and then the world, will be tested. Moreover, it is this message that will enrage the king of the north.

Daniel 12 – Judgement is ended

Daniel

2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

This verse does not refer to the general resurrection of the righteous at the Second Advent, but to a special resurrection at the voice of God under the outpouring of the seventh vial (Revelation 16:17; Joel 3:16). God's people are delivered by the voice of God. The Holy Ghost is poured upon the living saints, glorifying them before their enemies (See Early Writings, pp. 15, 285, 286). Those who have died in the faith of the third angel's message are raised as glorified saints to hear God's covenant of peace with His people. Those also who led out in the crucifixion of Jesus will be resurrected to see Him come in glory (See Revelation 1:7; The Great Controversy, p. 637).

3 - Lessons from the Book of Daniel

The Book of Daniel teaches faithfulness in adversity, God's sovereignty over world events and individuals, the importance of prayer, the reality of end-time prophecies, and finding Jesus throughout the entire book as Michael (the Archangel) and the coming Messiah. Key lessons include remaining steadfast in God's principles even when pressured to compromise, understanding that God works through history, and recognizing the promise of everlasting life and resurrection for believers.




3 - *Lessons from the Book of Daniel*

God's Sovereignty: God controls kingdoms, steers history, and works for His people, even amidst confusion and sin in the world.

Faithfulness & Integrity: Daniel and his friends modelled unwavering commitment to God's principles (like diet and prayer) despite intense pressure, showing it's possible to live faithfully in hostile cultures.

Prayer as a Lifeline: Daniel's life highlights consistent, heartfelt prayer (praise, confession, intercession) as essential, even when it risks life, as seen in chapters 2, 6, and 9.




3 - *Lessons from the Book of Daniel*

Prophecy & End Times: Daniel reveals God's precise timetable, pointing to the fulfilment of prophecies related to the Messiah ([Daniel 9](#)) and the coming Kingdom, giving hope for the end times and Jesus' return.

Divine Assistance & Deliverance: God provides supernatural help, rescuing believers from trials (fiery furnace, lion's den) and granting wisdom and strength through His presence.

Jesus Throughout Daniel: The book reveals Jesus in various symbolic forms: the Stone ([2](#)), Son of God ([3](#)), Son of Man ([7](#)), and Michael the Archangel ([10, 12](#)).

Everlasting Hope: The book assures believers of an eternal kingdom and resurrection, reminding them that earthly struggles are temporary.




Conclusion

The conclusion of the Book of Daniel, emphasizes God's ultimate sovereignty, the coming of Christ's eternal kingdom, and the final judgment, with a call for faithfulness during a time of increasing knowledge and tribulation, culminating in resurrection and vindication for the righteous and eternal punishment for the wicked.

Christ's investigative judgment, which began in 1844, fulfilling [Daniel 8:14](#) (the 2,300-day prophecy), marking the antitypical Day of Atonement where sins are blotted out from the heavenly records and transferred to Satan (the scapegoat) before His Second Coming.




