# Health Snippet – Acerola

Acerola cherries (*Malpighia emarginata*) originate from Central and South America. Red in colour, its appearance is very similar to that of a cherry.

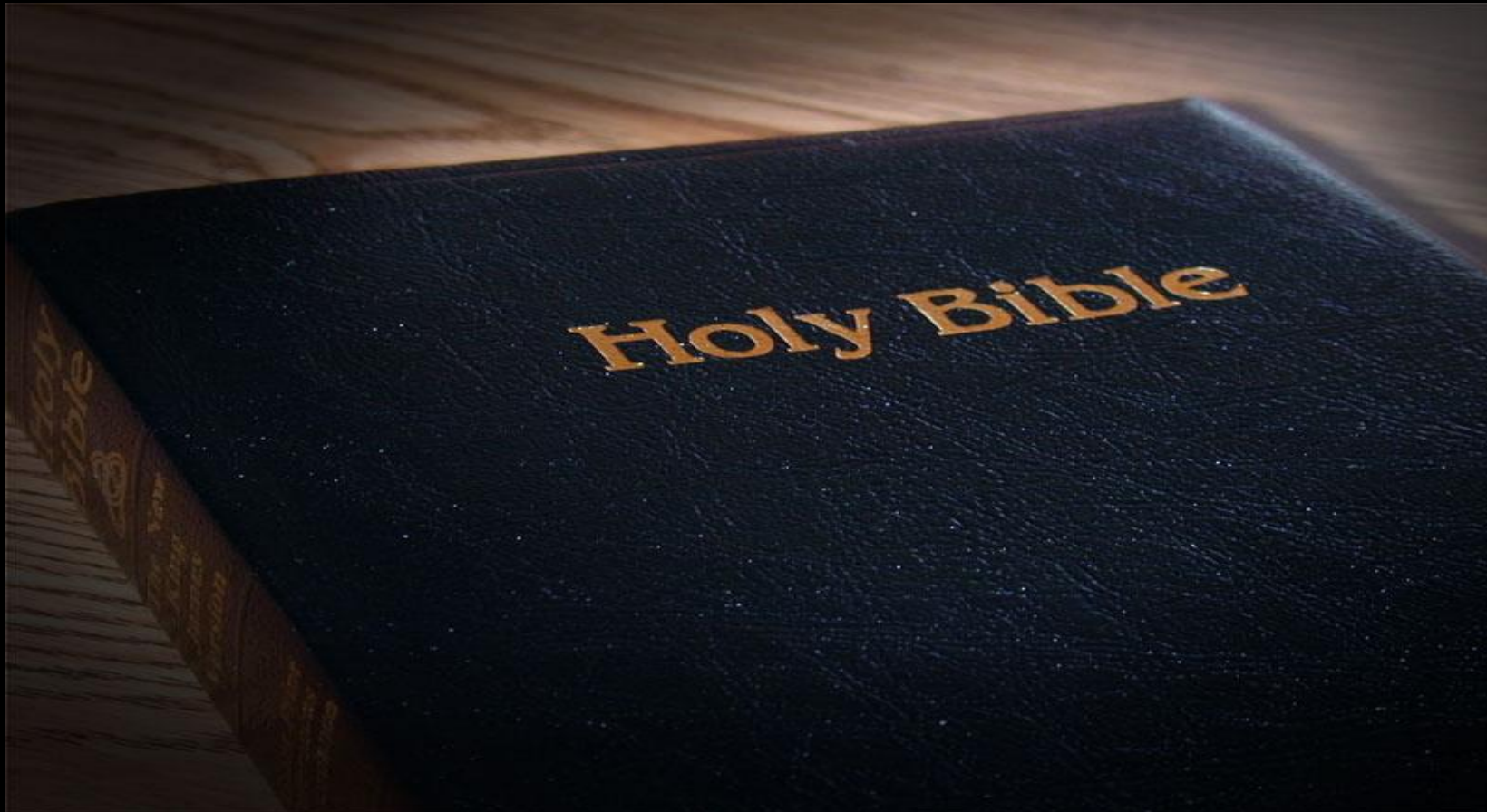

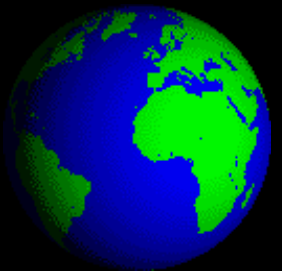

# Introduction

## 1. *The Divine Sonship & The Second Coming (Mark 9–10)*

**The Transfiguration (Mark 9):** this event is a literal, prophetic preview of the glorious Second Coming of Christ. Jesus is revealed as the supreme focal point of the kingdom, and the Father's voice ("Listen to him") underscores Christ's absolute authority.

**True Greatness:** Jesus upends worldly ambition by teaching that the greatest in the kingdom must be the servant of all.

**The Sabbath and the Law:** Jesus reinforces the sanctity and proper understanding of God's laws, emphasizing that spiritual priorities (like marriage and selfless devotion) far outweigh temporary, material wealth.



# Introduction

## 2. The Messiah's Authority & Earthly Rejection (Mark 11–13)

Cleansing of the Temple: Jesus demonstrates His divine authority to purify worship. Adventists interpret the cursing of the barren fig tree and the temple cleansing as a warning against religious formalism and a lack of spiritual fruitfulness.

The Olivet Discourse (Mark 13): This chapter is vital to Adventist eschatology. Jesus provides a prophetic outline of the signs preceding His Second Coming, warning believers to remain spiritually vigilant, steadfast, and ready for His imminent return.

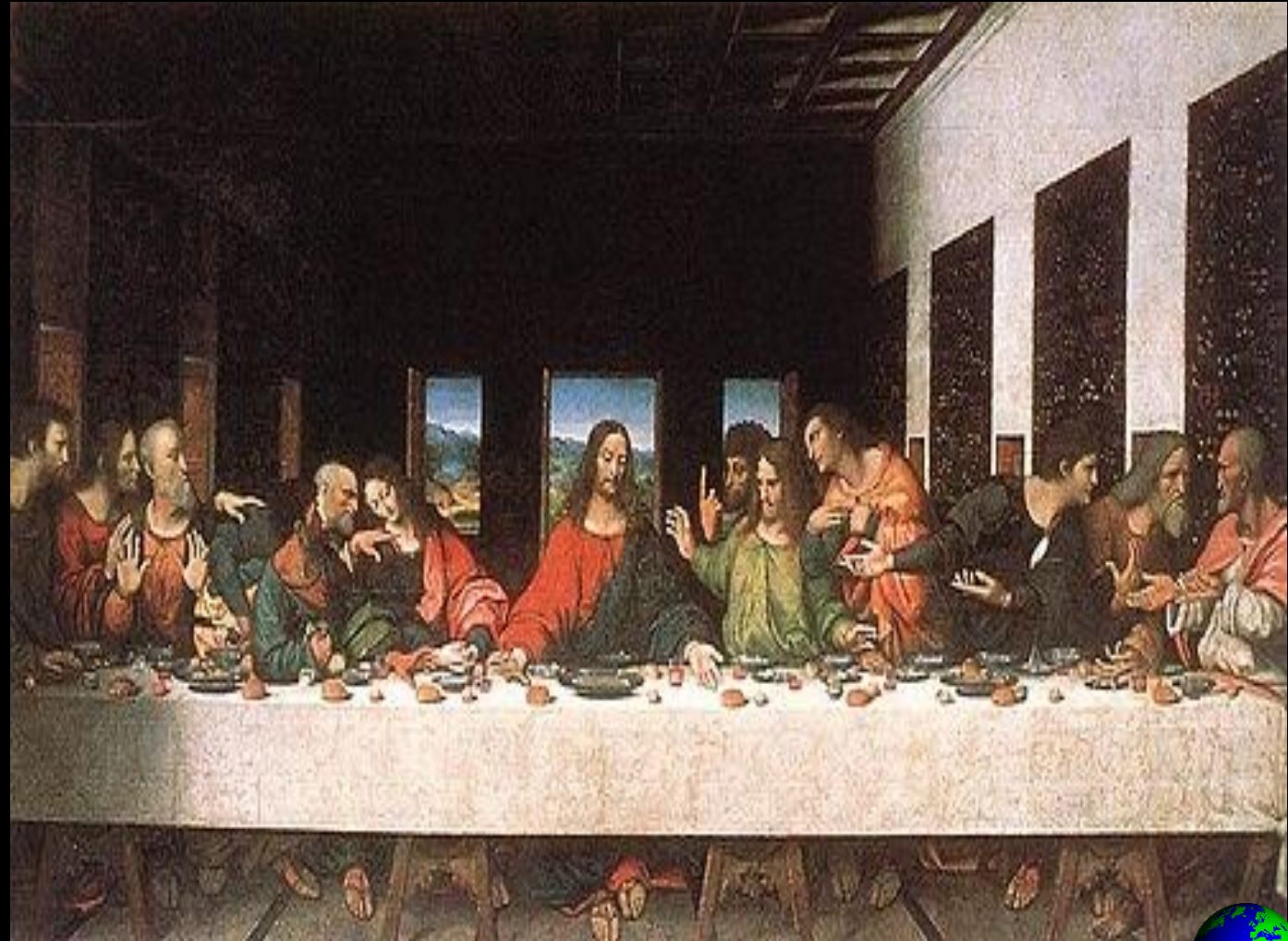


# Introduction

## 3. *The Climax of the Great Controversy (Mark 14–15)*

The Last Supper: Jesus reinterprets the Passover, instituting the Lord's Supper and signifying that His broken body and shed blood are the ultimate sacrifice for sin.

Gethsemane and the Cross: Here, Mark depicts the intense reality of the Great Controversy. The physical and spiritual anguish Jesus suffers highlights the heavy cost of redemption. His total submission to the Father's will secures humanity's salvation.

## 4. *The Resurrection & The Gospel Commission (Mark 16)*

**The Resurrection:** The empty tomb is the foundational proof of Christ's victory over sin and death, validating the Adventist hope of the bodily resurrection for all believers.

**The Great Commission:** The Gospel concludes with the mandate for the church to proclaim the Good News to all the world. This aligns closely with the focus on spreading the Three Angels' Messages and preparing the world for the imminent return of Christ.



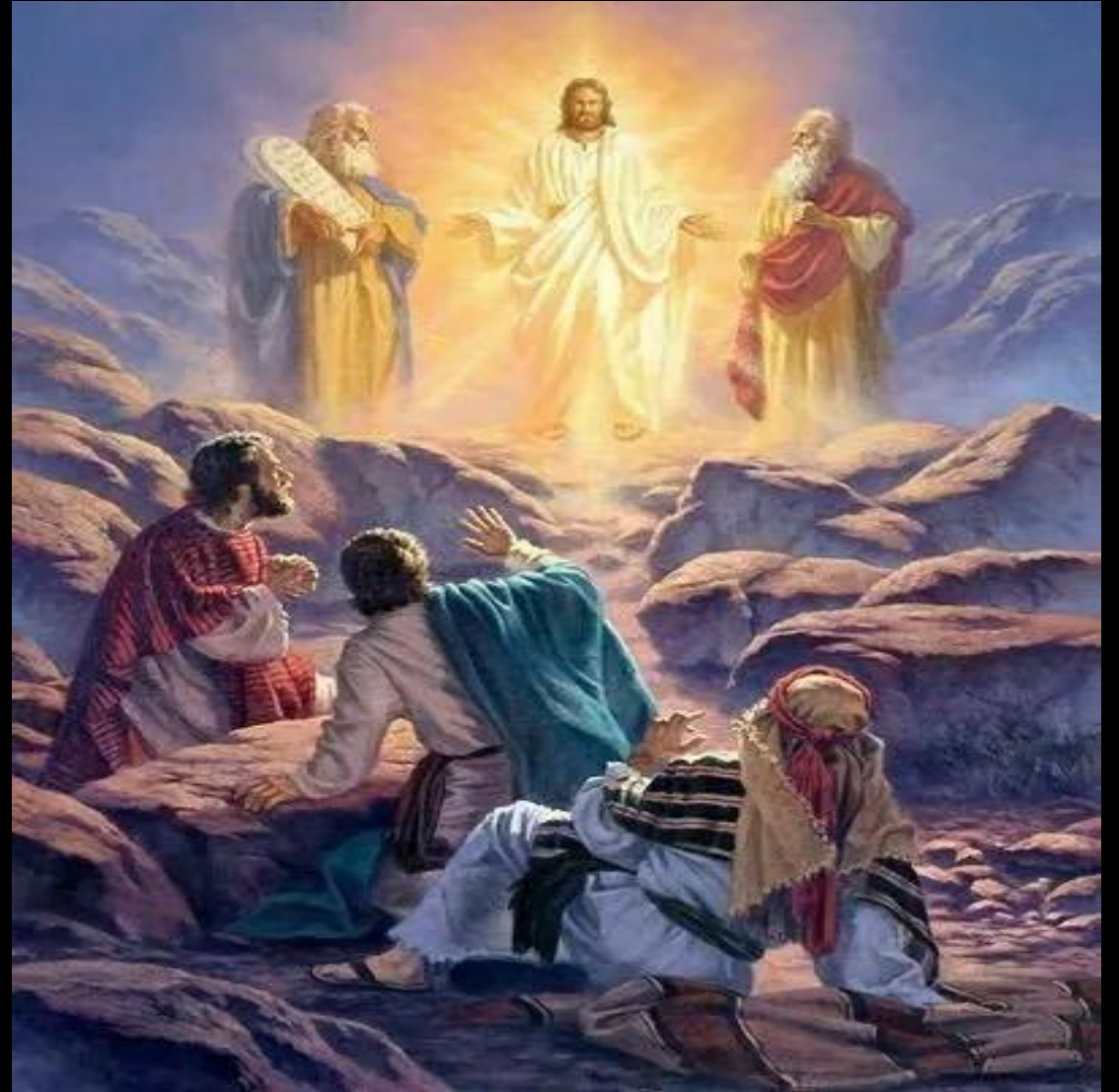

# 3 - Lessons in the book of Mark

## 1. Servant-Leadership and Humility:

While the disciples argued about who was the greatest, Jesus defined true greatness as becoming a servant to all ([Mark 9:35](#)).

## 2. The Power of Complete Faith and Prayer:

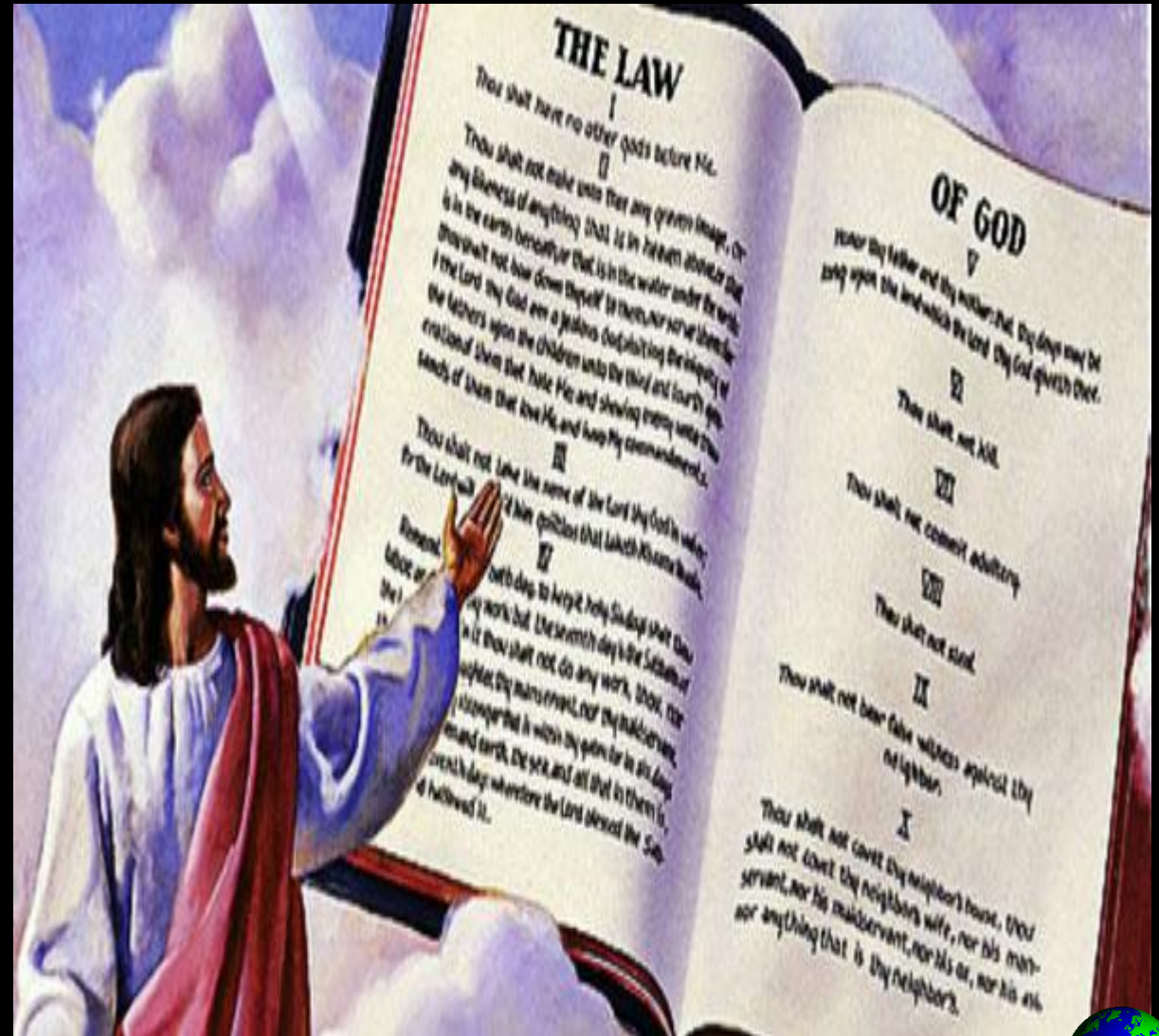
The disciples failed to cast out a demon because they relied on their own abilities instead of drawing strength from God. Jesus told the desperate father, "If thou canst believe, all things are possible" ([Mark 9:23](#)).



# 3 - Lessons in the book of Mark

3. Radical Allegiance to God's Law: When the rich young ruler asked how to inherit eternal life, Jesus pointed him to the commandments ([Mark 10:17-21](#)).

The remnant is called to uphold God's original ideals, standing firm in biblical morality despite a shifting, secular culture.

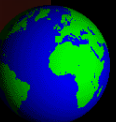
4. Watchfulness for the Second Coming: In the Olivet Discourse, Jesus outlines the signs of the end of the age and urges His followers: "Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is" ([Mark 13:33](#)).

This encompasses recognizing the signs of the times, avoiding deception, and being actively engaged in proclaiming the Three Angels' Messages.

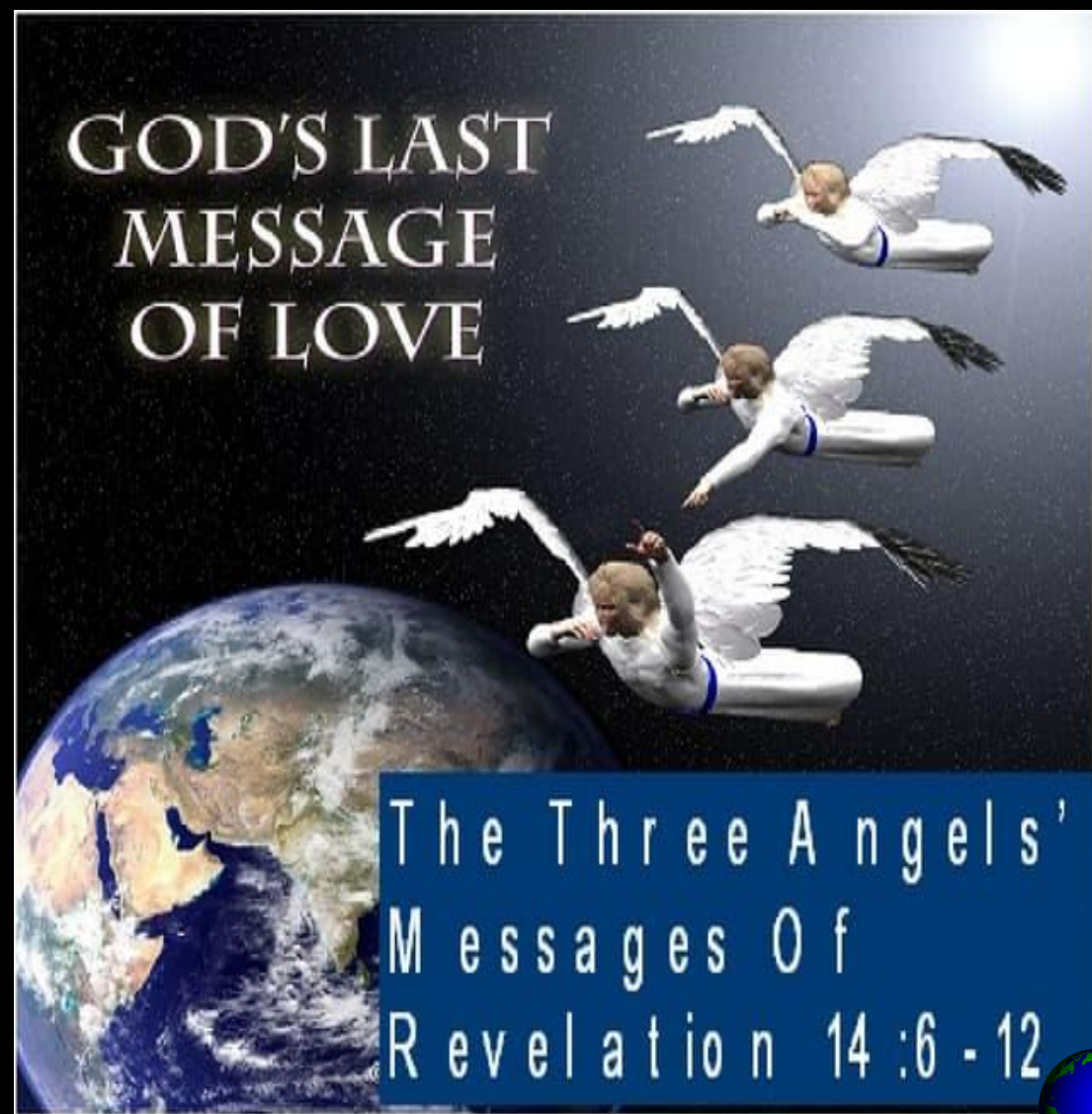

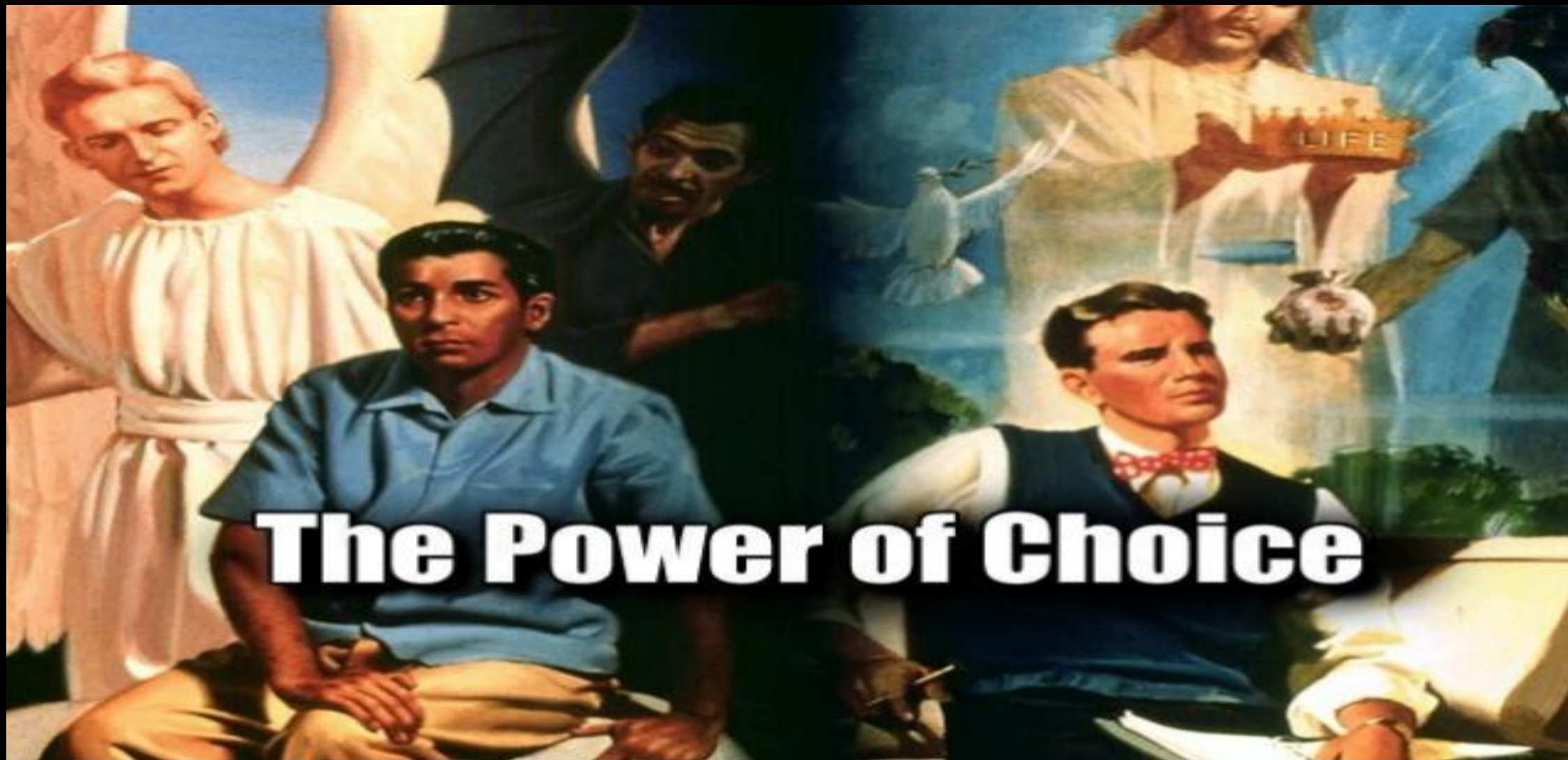


# Conclusion

The remnant is expected to pour out their resources and lives in loving service to advance God's kingdom before the close of probation.

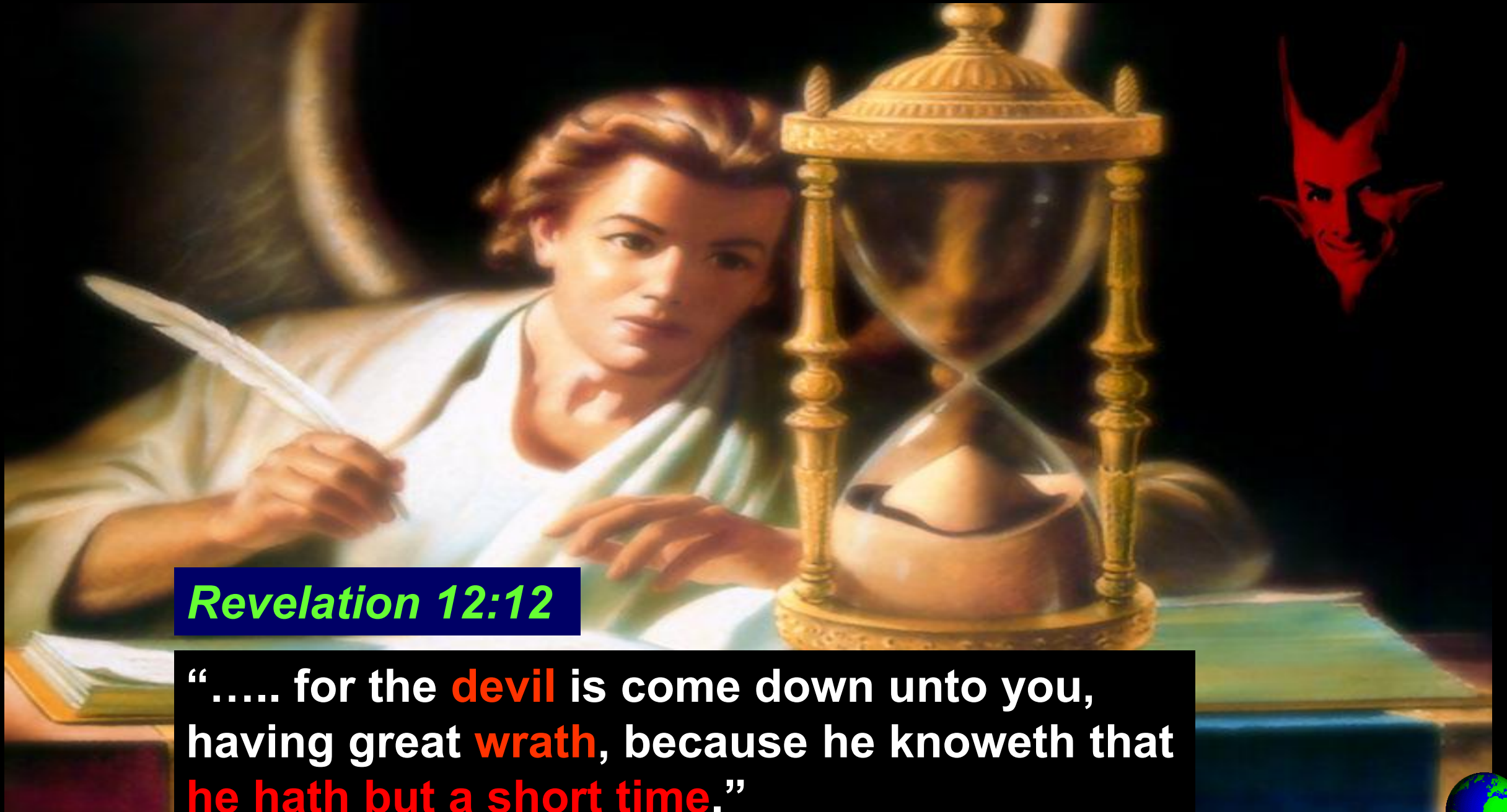

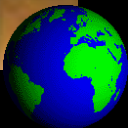

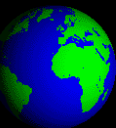
